State Route 18 Raised Curb Median In and Near Victorville

SAN BERNARDINO – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will begin work on a \$13.8 million safety project on State Route 18 (SR-18) in and near the city of Victorville from Amargosa Road to Cobalt Road. This project will construct a raised curb median, widen the roadway, and include the installation of a traffic signal at the Borego Road intersection.

The contractor, Sully-Miller Contracting Company from Brea, will begin placing k-rail, channelizers and plastic drums in preparation for construction work. Westbound lane #2 will be closed from Cobalt Road to Greenwood with the placement of plastic drums and channelizers during the project. Work will begin on May 17. Potential impacts to commuters are as follows:

- Amargosa Road to El Evado Road, both directions.
 - One lane may be closed with one lane remaining open in each direction,
 Monday through Friday from 9:00 p.m. to 7:00 a.m.
- Pacoima Road to Cobalt Road, both directions.
 - One lane may be closed with one lane remaining open in each direction at any time of day or night for the duration of the project.

The project is expected to be complete in November of 2022. Schedules can change due to inclement weather.
