




Existing Network

- Extensive coverage
- Strong regional connectivity
- Operates primarily on arterial streets
- Mostly direct and intuitive alignments



Proposed Changes

- Extend to new destinations
 - Cal State LA
 - South Pasadena Station
- Reduce inefficient services
 - Pico Rivera
 - La Mirada
- Simplify operations
 - Split Line 50 into 2 lines



West San Gabriel Valley

- Extend Line 30 to South Pasadena
 Gold Line Station
- Extend Line 10 to Cal State LA




Whittier/ La Mirada
