RE: Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission v. Cascade Natural Gas Corporation, Docket UG-210755

TO ALL PARTIES:

On September 30, 2021, Cascade Natural Gas Corporation (Cascade or Company) filed with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) revisions to its currently effective Tariff WN U-3 for natural gas service the Company provides in Washington. The effect of these filings would increase rates and charges for natural gas service. The Commission suspended the as-filed tariffs on October 13, 2021.

On October 26, 2021, the Commission entered Order 03, Prehearing Conference Order; Notice of Virtual Hearing (Order 03), which established a procedural schedule that included a hearing set for June 1-2, 2022, at 9 a.m. and allowed for a public comment hearing to be scheduled at a later date.

On February 18, 2022, counsel for Commission staff (Staff) informed the presiding officers that the parties had reached a full multiparty settlement in principle. On March 10, the Commission convened a virtual status conference and on March 11 the Commission entered Order 05, Second Prehearing Conference Order (Order 05) which revised the procedural schedule but maintained the evidentiary hearing dates of June 1-2, 2022.

The revised procedural schedule established by Order 05 includes a Public Comment Hearing set for May 25 at 6 p.m. To participate by phone, please call (253) 215-8782 and enter Conference
