#### Criteria for Enrollment

- ✓ High School Student with a disability.
  - ✓ court psycho/social report.
    - ✓ age requirement.
- ✓ Screened by the court for participation & ongoing relationship support from probation officers.

# Why Juvenile Courts?

- √ court selection/mandate
  - √delinquency;
  - ✓ dependency-neglect or
  - ✓ family- in-need-of-services (FINS) cases.

# Working for Independence Now!

- Basic Structure
  - -8 weeks
  - Soft Skills Training; Hands-on Participation
  - Community Work Placements
  - Meetings with probation officers
  - Court reports
  - Monthly Progress
  - Graduation


