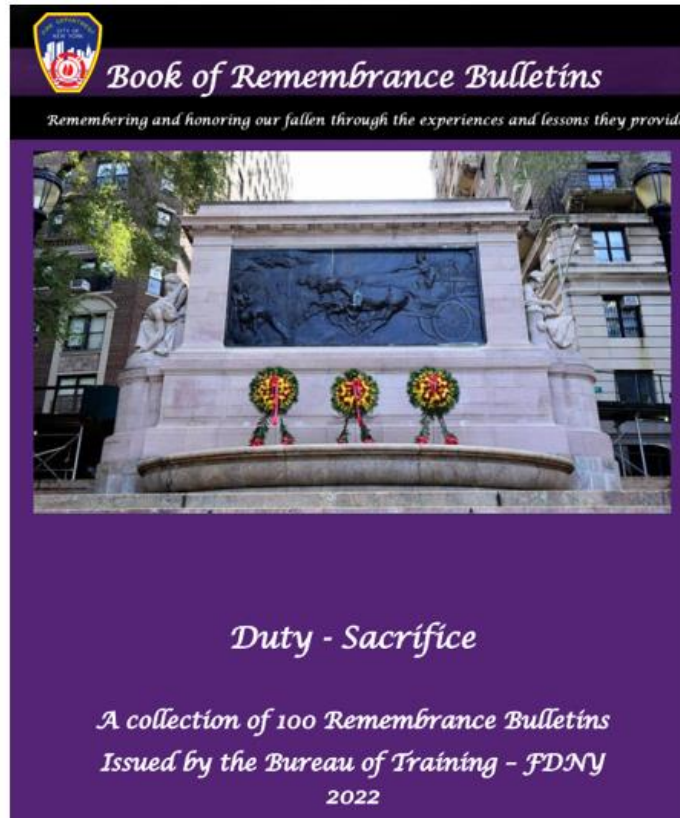

The Bureau of Training has published a Book of Remembrance Bulletins in honor of the New York City firefighters and FDNY EMS members who have made the Supreme Sacrifice in the performance of their duties. The goal of this book is to bring to light forgotten tragedies and provide learning points for current and future generations of the FDNY. The book contains one hundred Remembrance Bulletins discussing fires and emergencies that led to line of duty deaths. The 100 fires and emergencies chosen have transferable lessons to today. **We must never forget** while learning the experiences and lessons that these incidents provide. Please consider the following points.

- Consider discussing and drilling on these incidents on their anniversary – perhaps as part of roll call.
- It is important to take into consideration that many of the tools, safety equipment and knowledge of building construction that we take for granted was not available in past years.
- The FDNY is a learning organization and has continued to evolve throughout its long and storied history.
- We encourage all firefighters to read and learn about these incidents; therefore, honor our fallen members.
