Dear Director Garfield:

Pursuant to 13 C.F.R. § 123.3(a), I respectfully request the U.S. Small Business Administration (SBA) make a disaster declaration to provide SBA Disaster Loans for Dallas County in response to severe storms and flooding that occurred on August 22, 2022, through August 25, 2022.

The severe storms and flooding damaged many homes and businesses in Dallas County, creating an economic emergency for the residents of the county. The SBA should declare Dallas County a disaster area so that affected citizens and businesses can access long-term, low-interest loans to cope with economic injury and physical damage to homes and businesses.

On September 9, 2022, a joint preliminary damage assessment was conducted by local officials, the Texas Division of Emergency Management (TDEM), and SBA to determine the extent and type of disaster assistance necessary to assist with recovery efforts. The damage survey indicates that at least 47 total homes and businesses in Dallas County sustained major damages and suffered an uninsured loss of more than 40 percent.
