


## ONGOING WORK TO RESULT IN CLOSURE OF RAMP FROM SOUTHBOUND I-95 TO SOUTHBOUND MD 295

Weather permitting, the Maryland Transportation Authority (MDTA) will temporarily close the ramp from southbound I-95 to southbound MD 295 (Exit 52) on Friday, November 04, at 10 p.m. to 5 a.m. Monday, November 7. In addition, when the ramp from southbound I-95 to southbound MD 295 is closed, the ramp from Hanover Street to southbound I-95 must also be closed during the same time frame.



The detour for the ramp from Hanover Street to southbound I-95 will direct motorists to turn right onto E. McComas Street, to E. McComas Street on-ramp to southbound I-95.
