Reestablish a Reward Offer for the Murder of Huntington Park Police Officer Robert Keller

Officer Keller was dispatched to 6509 Pacific Blvd. in Huntington Park, a location doing business as the "Wonder Shop," on October 5,1967, to investigate a "silent" burglar alarm call. He confronted the armed burglary suspect inside the location. Officer Keller, who exchanged gunfire with the suspect, suffered gunshot wounds in the gun battle and succumbed to his injuries.

Los Angeles County Sheriff's Department (LASD) Homicide Bureau detectives, assisted by officers of the Huntington Park Police Department, conducted a rigorous and robust investigation at the time of the murder but were unable to identify the suspect. The case has remained unsolved and open with current LASD Homicide detectives assigned to the Unsolved Unit continuing to investigate the murder by utilizing the latest scientific methods and technologies.

LASD investigators believe a reward would bring attention to the case and encourage witnesses that might have seen and/or know the identity of the suspect(s) to

come forward and provide information to identify the individual (s) responsible for this crime. The Board of Supervisors established the reward on April 18, 2023, and approved an extension on July 11, 2023. The reward expired on January 12, 2023, but investigators
