Pursuant to the Amended Board of Health Regulation approved on November 2, 2021, please accept this Memorandum as notice that as of today Montgomery County has been an area of "substantial transmission" of COVID-19 for 7 consecutive days.

Effective November 20 at 12:01 a.m. all persons in Montgomery County over the age of two must wear a face covering in any location accessible to the public (subject to exceptions described in paragraph 3(b) of the Regulation).
