CARICOM-Caribbean Trade Exploration

Global NY is recruiting New York State (NYS) companies to participate in a **Trade Exploration to the CARICOM-Caribbean region** — providing market intelligence and funding to support export opportunities.

Interested companies should apply to the **Export**Marketing Assistance Service (EMAS) program, designed to help businesses find sales agents or distributors abroad. Five companies will be selected to participate in this Trade Exploration to the CARICOM-Caribbean and will receive a customized regional market intelligence report and a prequalified list of potential partners from Global NY's foreign office.

Deadline for EMAS application form: February 4, 2022

State Trade Expansion Program (STEP) funds are currently available for selected companies to be **reimbursed** for a significant portion of their travel to the Caribbean and accommodation expenses along with an appointment setting fee of \$2,000 for meetings with identified distributors/sales agents.
