## BE SEEN, BE ALERT AND BE SAFE while biking and walking in Prince George's County!





#### BE SEEN

- Wear bright and reflective clothing while biking and walking.
- When it's dark, use a white front light and red rear light, while biking.
- Bike with traffic never against it.
- While walking, carry a flashlight or use the light from your phone to be seen by motorists.
- Walk on sidewalks and cross at crosswalks and intersections. If a sidewalk isn't available, walk on the shoulder far from vehicles facing traffic.

### **BE ALERT**

- Eliminate distractions. No texting or talking on the phone while walking or biking.
- Obey traffic signs, signals and road markings.
- Look ahead for hazards, blindspots and situations to avoid.

#### **BE SAFE**

- Always look left, right and left again. Make sure it's safe before crossing the street.
- When biking, always wear a helmet with a hard shell and use hand signals when turning or stopping.
