This listing is available for 90 days. Entries on the report are sorted by agency, then by unit, and then by social security number. Agencies with no affected employees will have no data listed under the report ID. This is a one-time report and a hard copy will not be provided to departments.

Agencies must review listing PDB7883 to ensure that the records reflect the GEN and/or SAL, if entitled. Employees who separated from state service without fault prior to the effective date of the salary increase with lump sum pay extending beyond July 1, 2022 and who were eligible for the GEN and/or SAL at the time of separation should have their lump sum adjusted to reflect the increase.
