IDENTIFICATION, RESIDENCY, AND LEGAL PRESENCE REQUIREMENTS FOR NON-UNITED STATES CITIZENS

As part of a nationwide effort to enhance the issuance of secure identification credentials, Non-United States (U.S.) Citizens applying for a Pennsylvania (PA) learner's permit, driver's license, and/or photo identification card must present documentation issued by the U.S. Department of Homeland Security (DHS) establishing their lawful presence in the U.S. The Pennsylvania Department of Transportation (PennDOT) verifies immigration documents electronically using the U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services' Systematic Alien Verification for Entitlements (SAVE) Program. Expiration dates of products are determined based upon an individual's authorized length of stay as approved by DHS and verified through SAVE.

Verification through SAVE is often completed during the initial verification conducted at the time of application. However, there are instances where SAVE is unable to verify an individual's status and authorized length of stay during the initial verification. In these instances, PennDOT must resubmit the verification through SAVE for additional verification, and occasionally third level verification. Additional and third level verification responses can take 30 or more federal working days to be provided by SAVE. Verification response times for additional and third level verification should be considered when planning to visit a Driver License Center to make initial application or renew.

Age Requirements for Non-U.S. Citizens:

- Individuals applying for a Non-Commercial Driver's license must be at least 16 years of age.
- Individuals applying for an Identification (ID) Card must be at least 10 years of age.
- Individuals transferring a Non-Commercial Driver's License must be at least 16 ½ years of age.
- Individuals applying for a Learner's Permit must be at least 16 years of age.
- Out-of-State Learner's Permits cannot be transferred to Pennsylvania.
- Individuals applying for or transferring a Commercial Driver's License (CDL) must be at least 18 years of age for intrastate driving or 21 years of age or older for interstate driving.

Acceptable List of Documents for Proof of Residency for Applicants 18 Years of Age or Older:

The proof of residency documents must have your name and official Pennsylvania street address on it.

- Post-marked mail/package labels through USPS, UPS, FedEx etc.
- A W-2 form/pay stub
- · Lease agreements or mortgage documents
- Official Tax Records reflecting current name and address
- · Current, unexpired PA driver's license or photo ID card
- PA vehicle registration card
- · Auto insurance card
- A computer-generated utility bill showing your name and address (cellphone, cable, electric, gas)

NOTE: If you reside with someone, and have no bills in your name, you will still need to provide two proofs of residency. One proof is to bring the person with whom you reside along with their Driver's License or Photo ID to the Driver License Center. You will also need to provide a second proof of residency such as post-marked mail/package labels through USPS, UPS, FedEx, etc. that has your name and address on it. The address must match that of the person with whom you reside.

Individuals must present the appropriate DHS-issued documents establishing lawful presence. Original documents must be presented at the time of application.

I-797 receipt notices for applications for extension/change in status (I-539), employment authorization (I-765), or extensions in length of stay (I-129) will be reviewed and may be accepted as proof of pending action with DHS. However, not all I-797 receipts are acceptable (e.g., petition for relative (I-130)). In some cases, copies of an I-797 receipt or approval notice may be acceptable.

Certificates of Naturalization and Citizenship are also verified through SAVE.

If ineligible for a Social Security Number, a letter from the Social Security Administration indicating ineligibility is required and must be presented with each application.

Unless issued commercial driver's license, providing proofs of residency is a one-time requirement when making application for a first-time learner's permit/driver's license or photo identification card. Commercial driver's license holders who have a change of address must visit a PennDOT Driver License Center and provide one (1) proof of residency. A non-commercial driver's license and photo identification card change of address can be completed online or through the mail.

Individuals whose SAVE verification requires additional verification, or who do not present all required documents, will be provided with PennDOT Non-Native Born U.S. Citizen/Non-U.S. Citizen Courtesy Form DL-160. If all required documents are not presented, a SAVE verification will not be completed.

Automatic Employment Authorization Document (EAD) Extension

Certain renewal applicants who have filed Form I-765 qualify for an automatic extension of their EAD while their application is pending. Applicants qualify for this extension if they properly filed Form I-765 for a renewal of their EAD before their current EAD expired and are otherwise eligible for a renewal. To be eligible, the renewal application must be under a category that is eligible for an automatic extension and the category on their current EAD matches the "Class Requested" listed on the Form I-797C Notice of Action, Receipt Notice. (For Temporary Protected Status (TPS) beneficiaries or pending applicants, the EAD and the notice must contain either the A12 or C19 category, but the categories do not need to match each other.) All extensions must verify in SAVE before a driver's license or photo identification card can be issued.

Grace Periods and Employment Authorization Extensions (240 days)

SAVE automatically adds any applicable grace period or employment authorization extension (i.e., 240 days) provided by DHS to the expiration date of authorized stay or employment.
