CTE STUDENTS: CATCH THE WAVE SCHOLARSHIP

Award covers up to two years of tuition and other expenses

Now is the time to apply for the Washington Award for Vocational Excellence (WAVE) Scholarship. The Legislature created this scholarship to help career and technical education (CTE) high school and community college students achieve their education and career goals.

The application window is Feb. 1-March 17, 2023.



Who is eligible?

This year's graduating high school students (Class of 2023), along with community and technical college students who have completed at least one year of a professional-technical program. High school CTE students must have completed or be in the process of completing their second course in a single CTE pathway.



How much does it pay?

Funds are limited and awards may vary. The minimum award is \$4,500 per year for up to two years, or \$9,000. The maximum award is \$11,700 per year for up to two years, or \$23,400.



Where can the award be used?

The WAVE award may be used at Washington's community and technical colleges, regional and research universities, accredited independent colleges, and licensed private vocational schools.
