Upcoming solicitation expected November 2022. Grant award expected Spring 2023. EPA intends to award **one \$500,000 grant** to provide technical assistance support for land banking approaches for brownfields revitalization. The period of performance will be **4 years.**

Grant 5: Research, Technical Assistance, and Related Outreach on Land Banking Approaches for Brownfields Revitalization

Goal: Introduce communities to various brownfields and land banking approaches and expand community use of land banks as a tool for brownfields revitalization.



Types of Activities that help communities understand land banking approaches for brownfields revitalization may include:

- Conducting research
- Developing guides on best practices
- Lessons learned
- Effective strategies and model approaches
- Promoting awareness of informational materials
- Providing direct technical assistance

National Research opportunities:

- 4. Minimizing displacement and gentrification resulting from brownfields reuse
- 5. Land bank strategies as tools for brownfields revitalization (Focus of this flyer)
