Building envelope improvements will benefit quality of life and appeal of the Sunderson Heights Neighborhood.
City of Grinnell	Grinnell Pilot Rehab Program	\$1,000,000	13	6	0	7	Grinnell will use the grant funds to improve blighted structures. At least 6 owner-occupied homes near downtown Grinnell will be improved and the dilapidated downtown Beyer Building will be redeveloped into 7 rental units, saving it from demolition.
City of Keokuk	Keokuk Home Rehab Pilot Grant	\$600,000	27	10	14	3	Keokuk will use the grant funds for the rehabilitation of existing homes and to acquire, rehabilitate and sell or rent two currently abandoned properties to income-qualified households. The rehab funds will be available for both owner-occupied and rental properties. Exterior rehab items such as roofs, siding and windows will be a priority for the rehabilitation funds.
City of Mason City	Mason City Downtown West Reinvestment District	\$1,000,000	47	15	32	0	Mason City will use the grant funds to provide grants to upgrade distressed housing in collaboration with local partners to purchase and renovate houses into homeownership units and make improvements to neighborhood infrastructure. Property owners must provide at least a 20% local match.
City of Washington	City of Washington Housing Rehab Pilot Program	\$400,000	14	14	0	0	Washington will use the grant funds to rehabilitate a minimum of 12 owner-occupied homes in the area surrounding the downtown business and commercial district. Funds will be used for exterior and interior repairs that ensure code compliance, extend the useful life of the property, and address health and safety issues and concerns. Activities that improve a home's energy efficiency may also be conducted. Rehabilitation activities will prioritize exterior repairs that are impactful to the neighborhood, however interior rehabilitation and energy efficiency improvements will also be eligible.
