Enrollment Information and Most Commonly Used Documents

Age of the StudentTo be eligible for school:

• Students must turn 4 by September 1.

Identity of Person Enrolling Student and Relationship to Student

- Identification AND
- Proof of relationship to student
- Other cases, work with the staff to determine appropriate form and required documentation

Residency in Montgomery County Homeowner

• Provide copy of current property tax bill **Renter**

• Provide copy of current lease (if the original term of the lease is expired, a copy of lease and current utility bill)

Shared housing

• Provide documentation from homeowner or renter and MCPS Form 335-74, *Shared Housing Disclosure*

Homeless

• Contact MCPS Homeless Liaison 240-740-4511

Proof of Family Income

• Family must provide proof of current income for all adults in the household

Examples

- Birth certificate
- Passport/Visa
- Physician's certificate
- Baptismal or Church Certification
- Hospital certificate
- Parent's notarized affidavit (sworn notarized statement attesting to the accuracy of the date of birth)
- Birth registration
- Other legal or notarized identification

Examples of Proof of Parent/ Guardian Identity that includes a photograph:

Examples

- Driver's license
- Passport/Visa
- Motor Vehicle Administration Identification Card
- Other legal form of identification

Examples of Proof of parent/ guardian relationship to student:

- Birth certificate of student which identifies the parents
- Court order
- Separation agreement or divorce decree
- Other legal form of identification

• Supporting documents must be in the name of parent/guardian at address shown on MCPS Form 335-74, *Shared Housing Disclosure Form*, include the name of the sending organization, and a date within 90 days of the current date.

Examples

- An acceptable document of address should be a communication from the following types of entities:
- Financial Institutions (i.e. banks, insurance companies, etc.)
- Utility Company (i.e. phone, water, power, etc.)
- Governmental (i.e. federal, state, local)
- Medical
- Religious
- Nonprofit/Community Organizations

- Examples
- Current income tax form
- Employment letter

• Last 3 pay stubs

- Unemployment benefits
- Notarized letter of financial support
- Temporary Cash Assistance (TCA)
