DESCRIPTION/ISSUE

The County Council asked the Office of Legislative Oversight (OLO) to prepare a report that describes the terms and conditions of the County Government's collective bargaining agreement (CBA) with County police officers. In Montgomery County, police officers are represented for collective bargaining purposes by the Fraternal Order of Police, Montgomery County Lodge 35, Inc. (FOP). This OLO report summarizes the provisions in the County's CBA with the FOP and discusses the degree to which the content of the collective bargaining agreement documents between Montgomery County and the FOP is accessible and comprehensible by a third-party reader.
