COUNCIL DECISION POINTS & COMMITTEE RECOMMENDATION

- This Special Appropriation was introduced on May 27, 2021.

DESCRIPTION/ISSUE

The State of Maryland and Montgomery County are employing multiple strategies to vaccinate all eligible people with one of the COVID-19 vaccines. As of June 10, 2021, 677,112 or 64.4% of County residents had received one dose of vaccine and 586,430 or 55.8% had received their full dose schedule. The County has a joint county/state mass vaccination site, County Health Department clinics, partnerships with community-based health providers, and support from the State equity team. This funding from the FEMA Emergency Protective Measures Grant will support the County's personnel and operating costs of administering vaccines.

SUBJECT: Special Appropriation #21-528 to the FY21 Operating Budget Montgomery County Government Department of Health and Human Services FEMA Emergency Protective Measures, \$6,704,931

I am recommending a special appropriation to the FY21 Operating Budget of the Department of Health and Human Services in the amount of \$6,704,931 to implement services in accordance with the FEMA Emergency Protective Measures Grant that the County has received from the Maryland Department of Health. This appropriation will fund the purchasing of vaccine related equipment and supplies, and the administration of the COVID-19 vaccines safely and effectively to County residents.

This increase is needed to support COVID-19 vaccine administration in Montgomery County. The funds will support personnel costs, costs associated with using facilities to administer the COVID-19 vaccines, storing and distributing vaccines, and emergency medical care associated with vaccine administration.

I recommend that you approve this special appropriation in the amount of \$6,704,931 and specify the source of funds as Maryland Department of Health, FEMA Emergency Protective Measures Grant.

Background

- Section 308 of the Montgomery County Charter provides that a special appropriation: (a) may be made at any time after public notice by news release; (b) must state that the special appropriation is necessary to meet an unforeseen disaster or other emergency or to act without delay in the public interest; (c) must specify the revenues necessary to finance it; and (d) must be approved by no fewer than six members of the Council.
- 2. The County Executive has requested the following FY21 Operating Budget appropriation increases for the Department of Health and Human Services.

- 3. This increase is needed to support the cost of administering COVID-19 vaccines in Montgomery County. The funds support personnel costs, costs associated with using facilities to administer the COVID-19 vaccines, storing and distributing vaccines, and emergency medical care associated with vaccine administration
- 4. The County Executive has requested a special appropriation to the FY21 Operating Budget in the amount of \$6,704,931 for the purposes outlined above and specifies that the source of funds will be Maryland Department of Health, FEMA Emergency Protective Measures Grant funds.
- 5. The public was notified by a news release and a public hearing was held.
