1. Bill 34-20, Police – Police Labor Relations – Duty to Bargain - Amendments was sponsored by Lead Sponsors Councilmember Riemer and Rice with Co-sponsors Councilmembers Jawando and Navarro.
2. A Public Hearing on Bill 34-20 was held on September 22, 2020 and a Public Safety Committee worksession was held on September 20, 2021.
