COUNCIL DECISION POINTS & COMMITTEE RECOMMENDATION

- A Transportation and Environment Committee worksession is scheduled for January 19, 2022.

DESCRIPTION/ISSUE

The appropriation is needed to authorize the expenditure of funds, received during FY21, for the replacement of roadside trees as required by Bill 41-12 – Streets and Roads – Roadside Trees – Protection. The money is from the Street Tree Planting Funds and can be used only for this purpose.

SUMMARY OF KEY DISCUSSION POINTS

- The Tree Planting Fund collected \$268,483 in FY21, \$193,483 more than had been estimated.

SUBJECT: Supplemental Appropriation #22-29 the FY22 Operating Budget
Montgomery County Government
Department of Transportation
Streets and Roads – Roadside Trees-Protection \$193,483

I am recommending a supplemental appropriation to the FY22 Operating Budget for the Department of Transportation in the amount of \$193,483. This appropriation will fund the replacement of Roadside Trees as required by Bill 41-12 – Streets and Roads – Roadside Trees-Protection.

This increase is needed to authorize expenditures of revenue received in FY21 above the \$75,000 originally appropriated. The funds requested in this supplemental were not previously appropriated because the revenue levels were unknown. Street Tree Planting Fund revenues can only be used to plant trees in the right-of-way of a public road in the County.

I recommend that the County Council approve this supplemental appropriation in the amount of \$193,483 and specify the source of funds as Street Tree Planting Fund.

Background

1. Section 307 of the Montgomery County Charter provides that any supplemental appropriation shall be recommended by the County Executive who shall specify the source of funds to finance it. The Council shall hold a public hearing on each proposed supplemental appropriation after at least one week’s notice. A supplemental appropriation that would comply with, avail the County of, or put into effect a grant or a Federal, State or County law or regulation, or one that is approved after January 1 of any fiscal year, requires an affirmative vote of five Councilmembers. A supplemental appropriation for any other purpose that is approved before January 1 of any fiscal year requires an affirmative vote of six Councilmembers. The Council may, in a single action, approve more than one supplemental appropriation. The Executive may disapprove or reduce a supplemental appropriation, and the Council may reapprove the appropriation, as if it were an item in the annual budget.
2. The County Executive has requested the following FY22 Operating Budget appropriation increases for the Department of Transportation:

3. This increase is needed to authorize the expenditure of funds received during FY21. Street Tree Planting Fund revenues can only be used to plant trees in the right-of-way of a public road in the County. These funds were not previously appropriated because the program was new and revenue levels are uncertain.
4. The County Executive recommends a supplemental in the amount of \$193,483 and specifies the source of funds as Street Tree Planting Fund.
5. Notice of public hearing was given, and a public hearing was held.
