DESCRIPTION/ISSUE

Montgomery County continues to support the vaccination of County residents against COVID-19 through clinics and special health initiatives. Ongoing funding is needed to support the administration of vaccinations. This funding will support the acquisition of equipment, supplies, and the hiring of medical staff to administer COVID-19 vaccines.

SUMMARY OF KEY DISCUSSION POINTS

- The Emergency Protective Measures, Vaccine Administration is a grant from the Department of Homeland Security, Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA), that is provided to the County through the Maryland Department of Health.
- The February 23, 2022, DHHS Pulse Report says that as of February 19, 2022, at least 95% of the total County population has received at least one dose of a COVID-19 vaccine; 85% of the total population has received at least two doses of vaccine; 52% of the fully vaccinated population has received a booster/additional dose; and 75% of fully vaccinated residents aged 65 and older has received a booster/additional dose.

SUBJECT: Special Appropriation #22-48 to the FY22 Operating

Budget Montgomery County Government Department of Health and Human Services FEMA Emergency Protective Measures Grant \$7,821,000 (Source of Funds: State Funds)

I am recommending a special appropriation to the FY22 Operating Budget of the Department of Health and Human Services (HHS) in the amount of \$7,821,000 for a Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) Emergency Protective Measures grant provided to the County via the Maryland Department of Health. This appropriation will fund the acquisition of equipment, supplies, and the hiring of medical staff to administer COVID-19 vaccines.

This increase is to support the Department of Health and Human Services with safely and effectively administering COVID-19 vaccinations to residents. The funding will be used to engage community partners to promote, administer, and manage COVID-19 vaccines.

I recommend that the County Council approve this special appropriation in the amount \$7,821,000 and specify the source of funds as State Funds.

<u>Department of Health and Human Services</u> <u>FEMA Emergency Protective Measures Grant</u> \$7,821,000 (Source of Funds: State Funds)

Background

- 1. Section 308 of the Montgomery County Charter provides that a special appropriation is an appropriation which states that it is necessary to meet an unforeseen disaster or other emergency, or to act without delay in the public interest. Each special appropriation shall be approved by not less than six Councilmembers. The Council may approve a special appropriation at any time after public notice by news release. Each special appropriation shall specify the source of funds to finance it.
- 2. The County Executive has requested the following FY22 Operating Budget appropriation increases for the Department of Health and Human Services:

- 3. This increase is to support the Department of Health and Human services with safely and effectively administering COVID-19 vaccinations to residents. The funding will support the acquisition of the equipment, supplies, and the hiring of medical staff to administer COVID-19 vaccines.
- 4. The source of funding for this appropriation is from the Maryland Department of Health, Prevention and Health Promotion Administration. The Emergency Protective Measures, Vaccine Administration is a public assistance grant funded through the Department of Homeland Security, Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA).

5. Notice of public hearing was given, and a public hearing was held.

Action

The County Council for Montgomery County, Maryland, approves the following actions:

1. A special appropriation to the FY22 Operating Budget of the Department of Health and Human Services is approved as follows:
