- Every 10 years
- Everyone counts
- Main purpose is for congressional representation

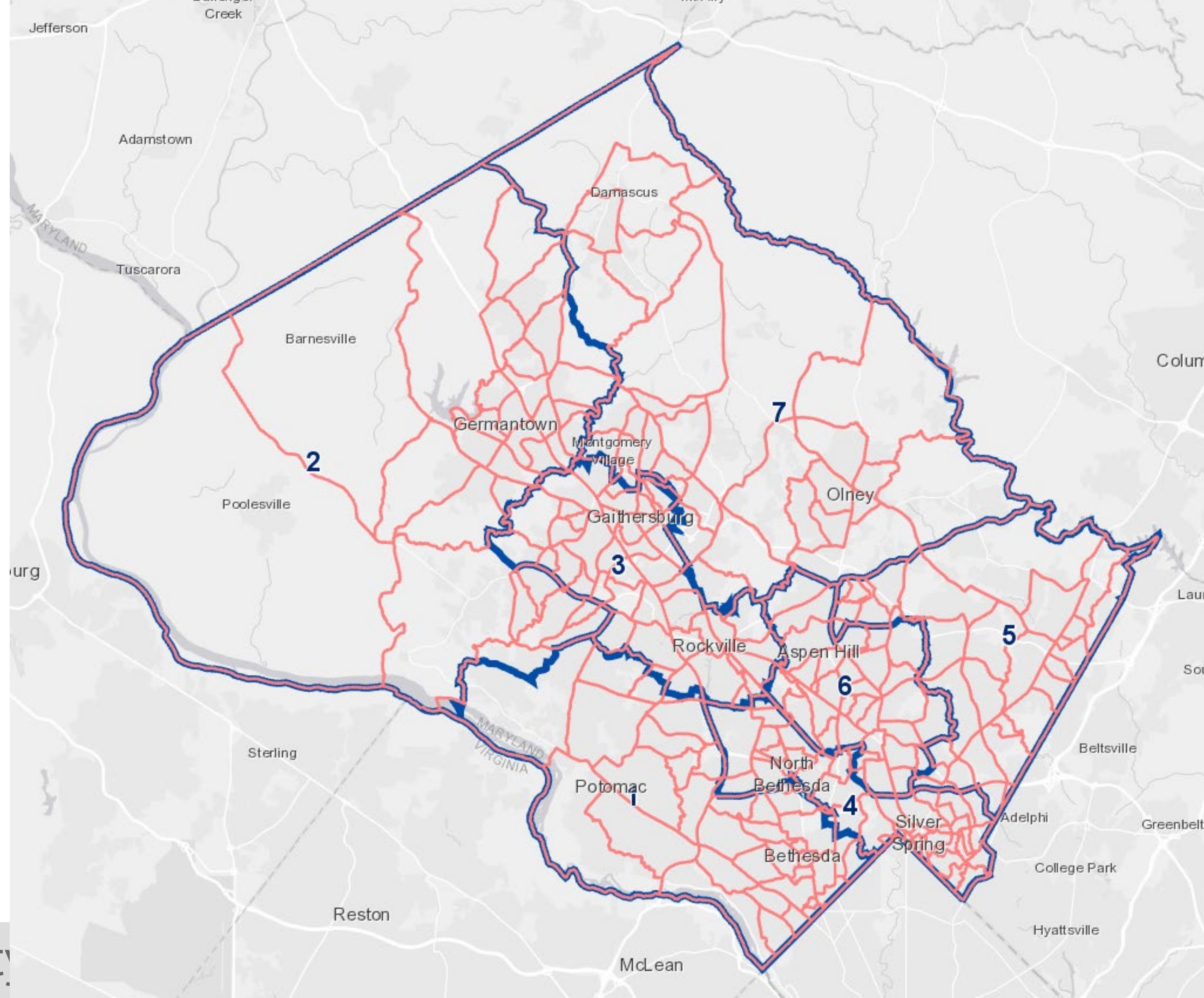
## American Community Survey (ACS)

- Annually
- 3.5 million household sample
- Detailed data on race, income, education, occupation, commuting, housing, etc.
- Data available in 1-year and 5-year tabulations

## Population Estimates Program

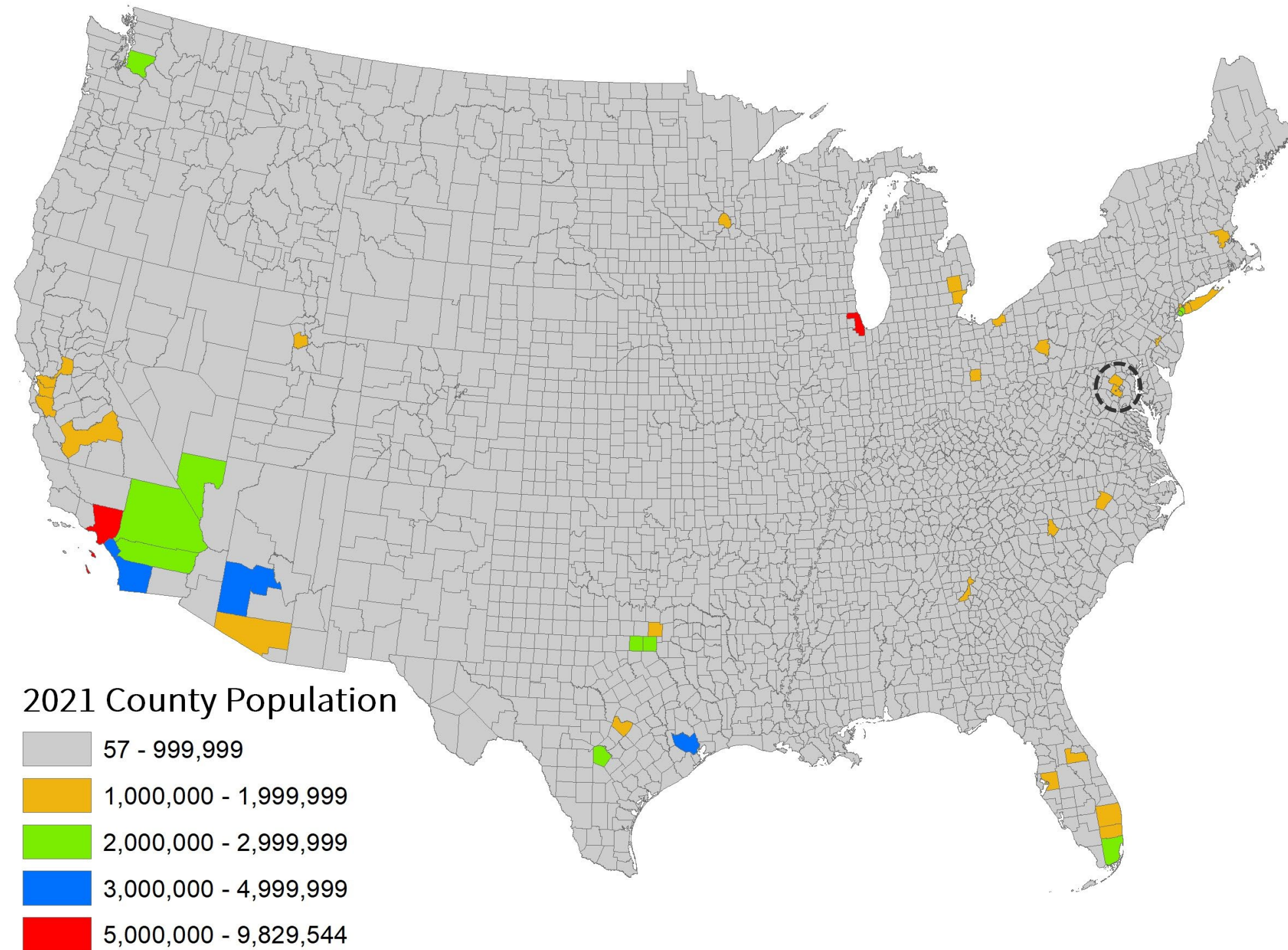
- Annually

- Age and race characteristics

# Montgomery County is the 44<sup>th</sup> largest county in the United States.



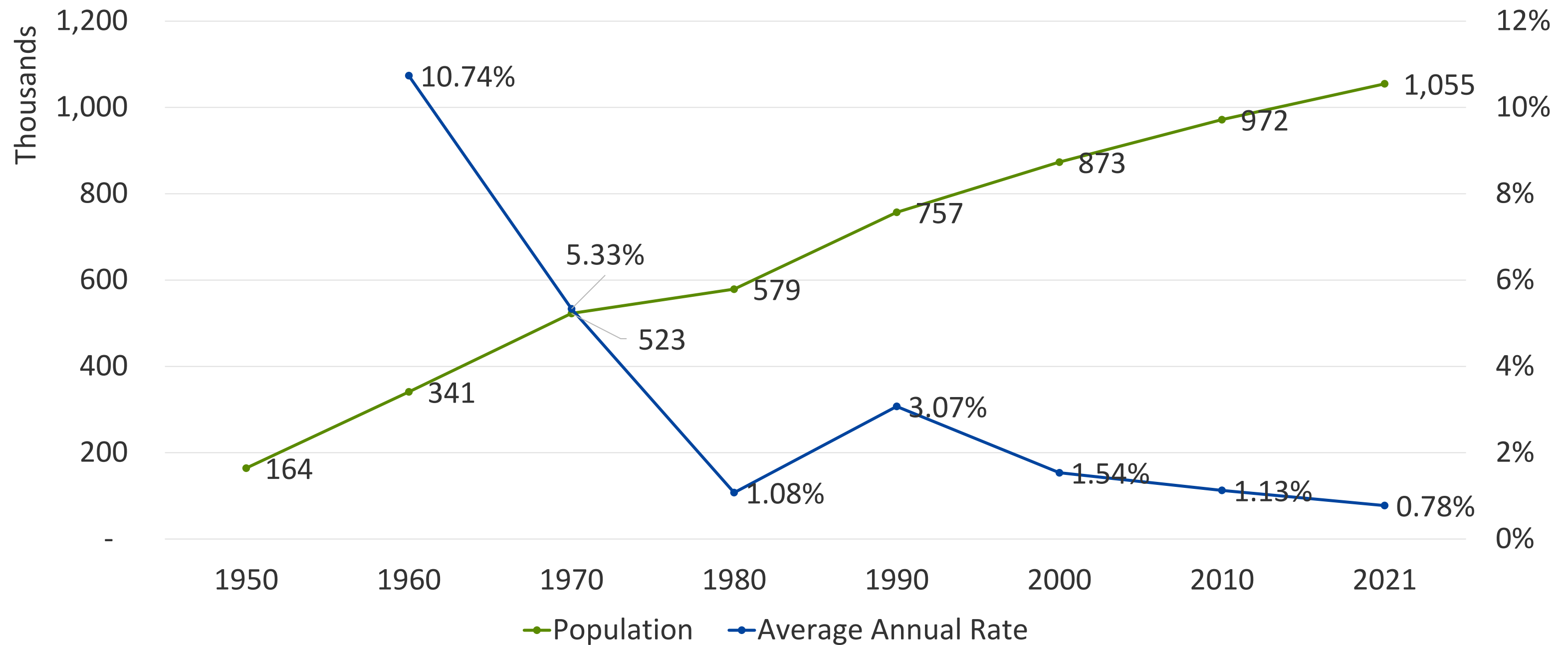
2021 pop = 1.05M

# Population growth rates reflect a mature, built out county.

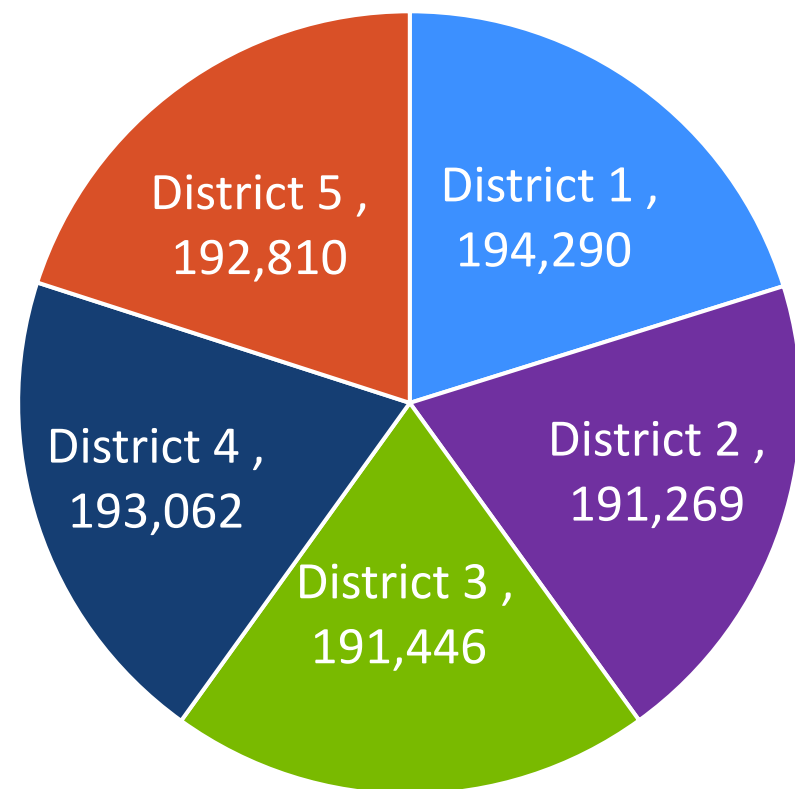

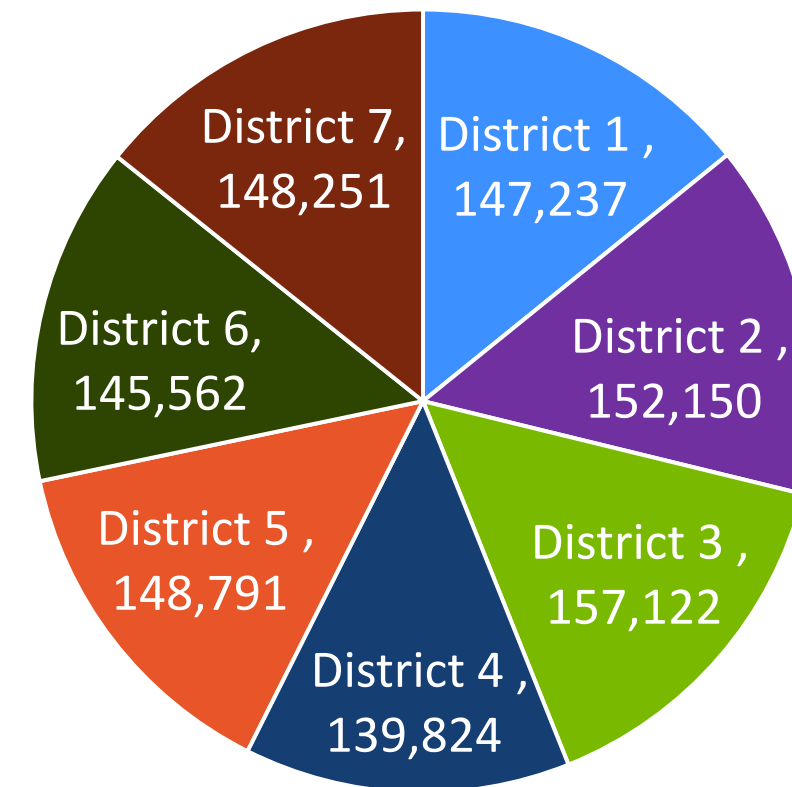
# New Council districts have approximately 44,000 fewer people than old districts

962,877



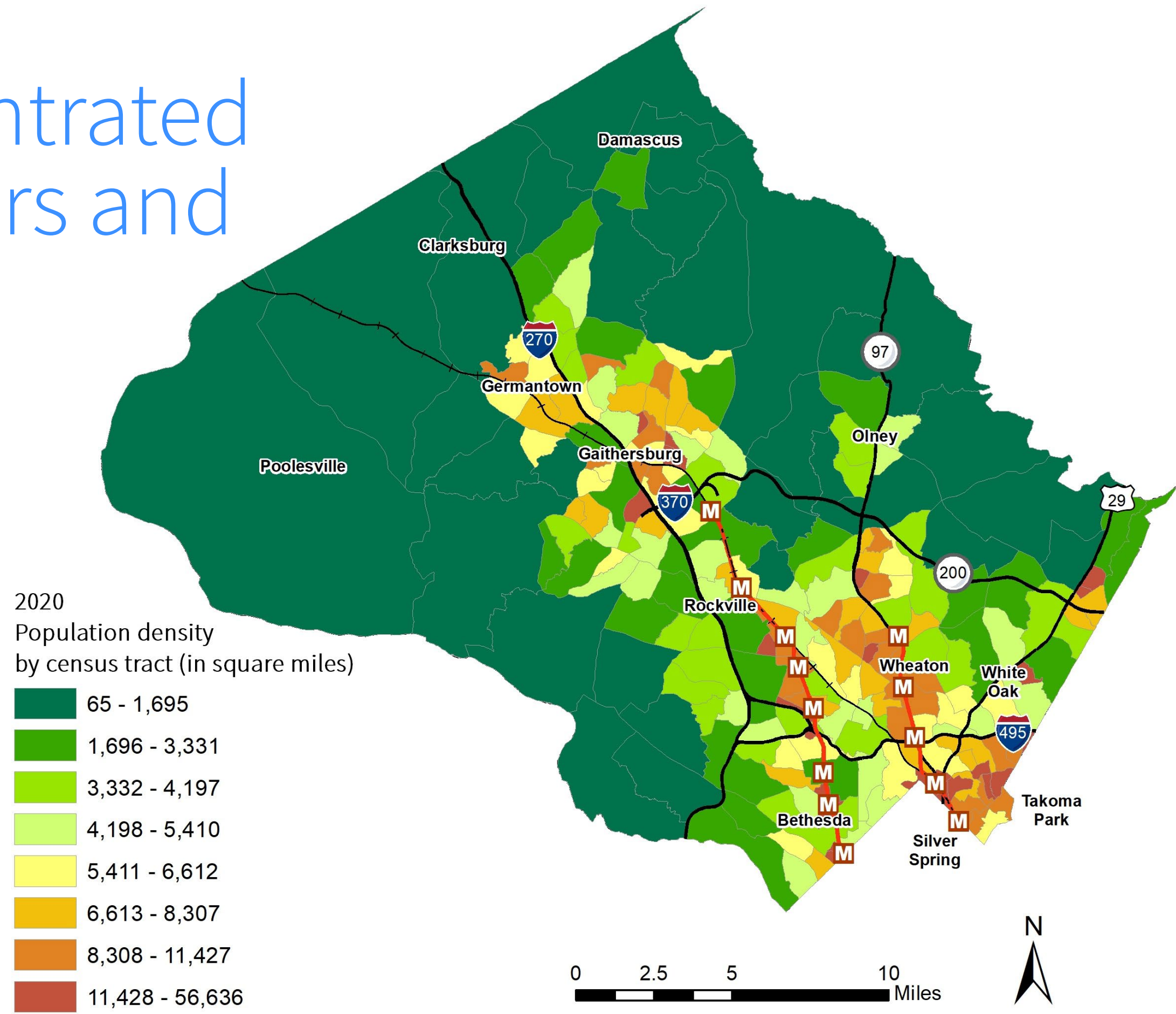

1,038,937



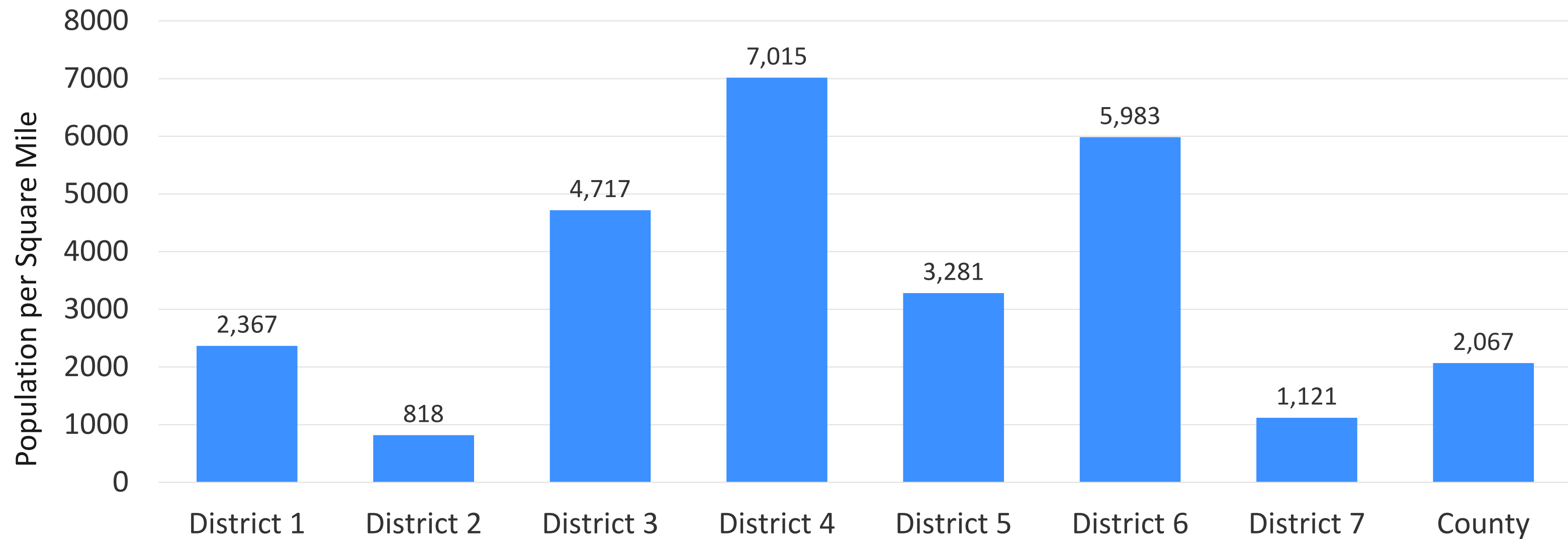

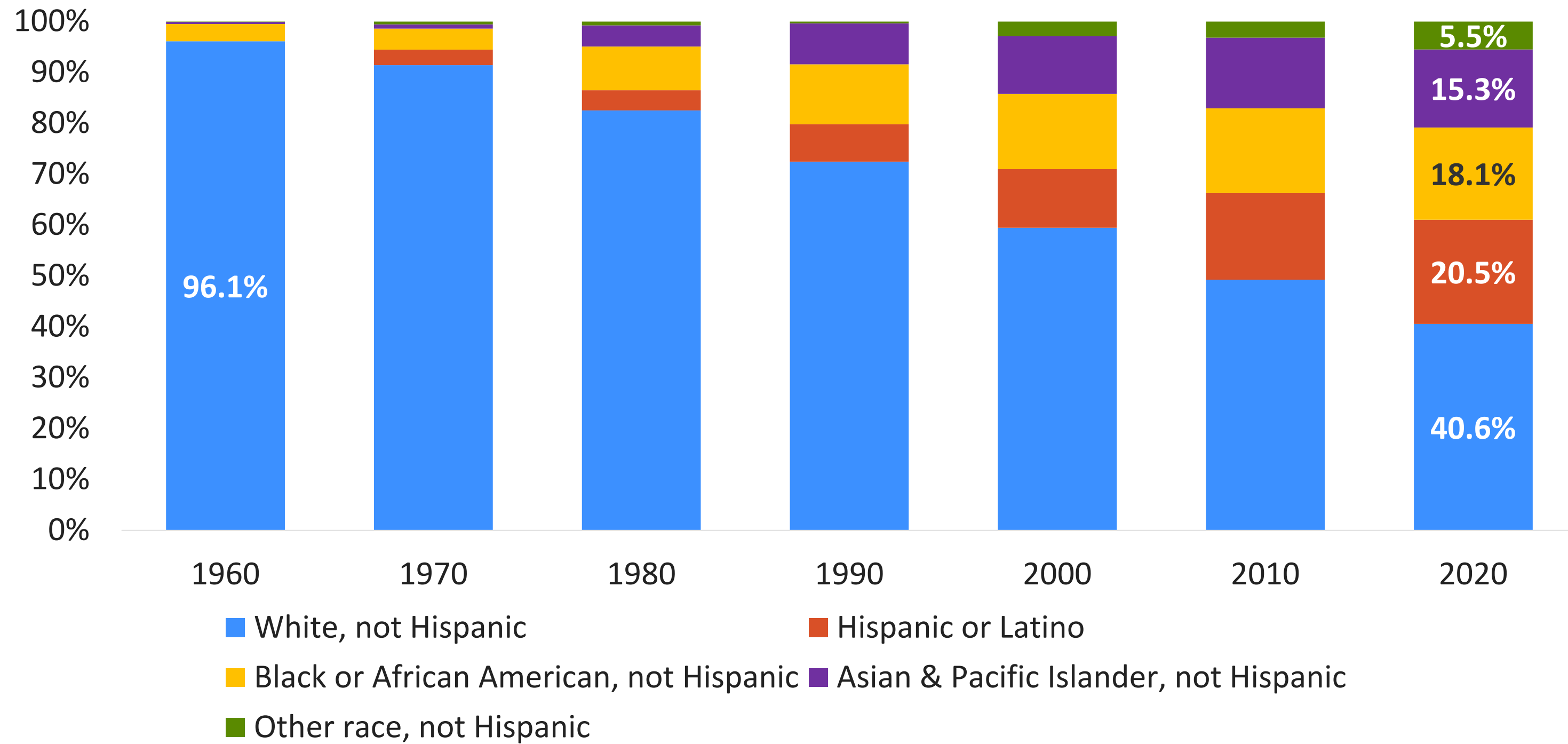

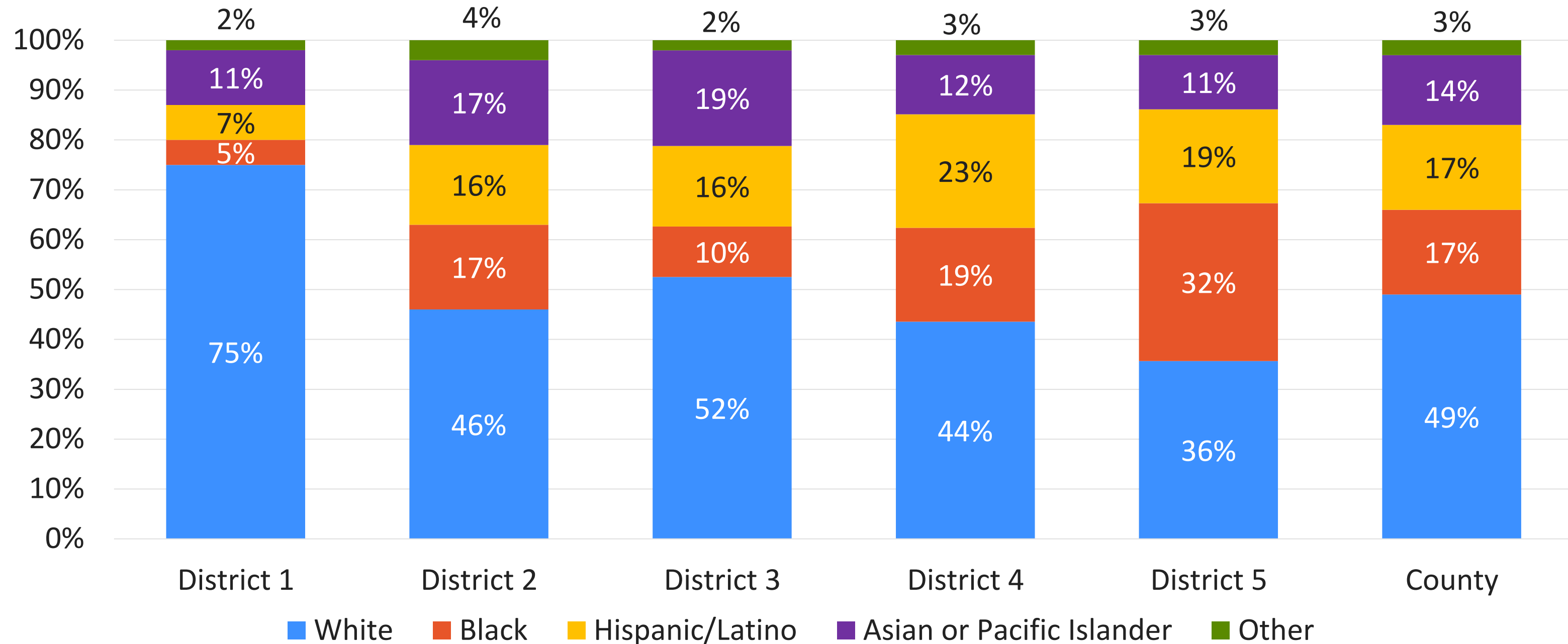

# Population by race/ethnicity (1960-2020)



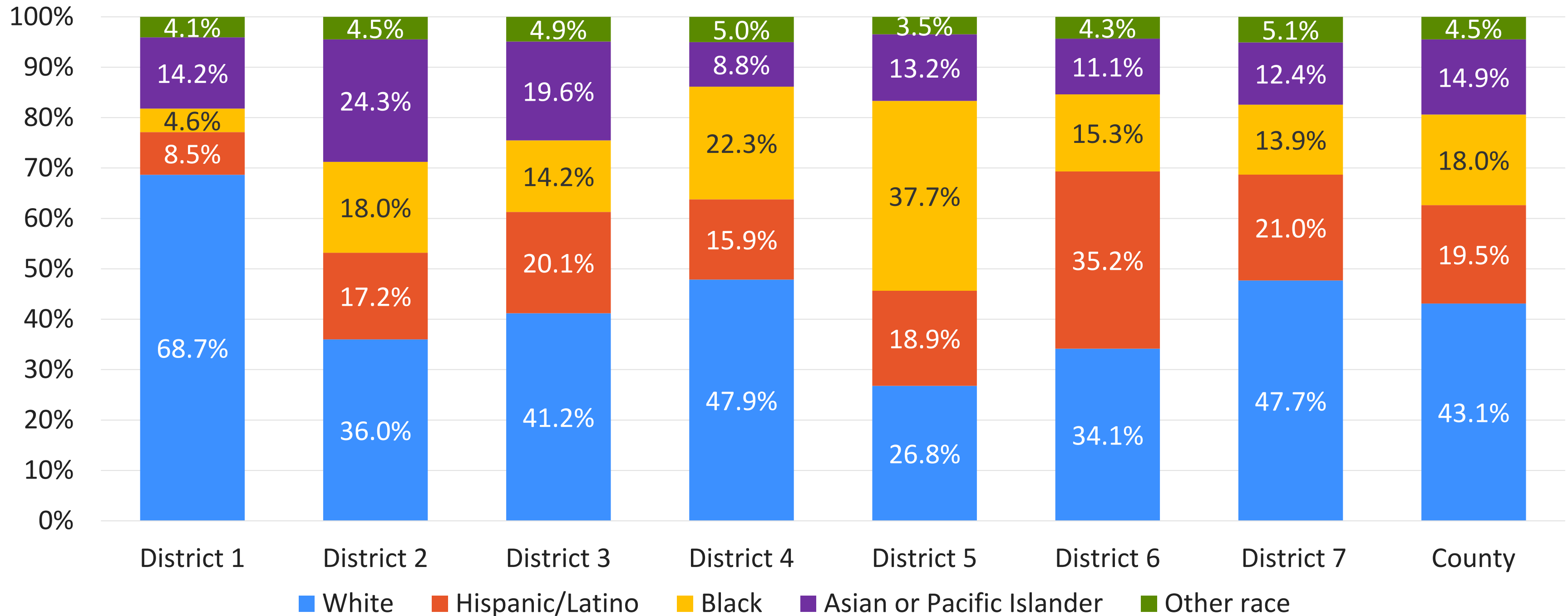

# 6 of 7 districts and the county overall are majority people of color today



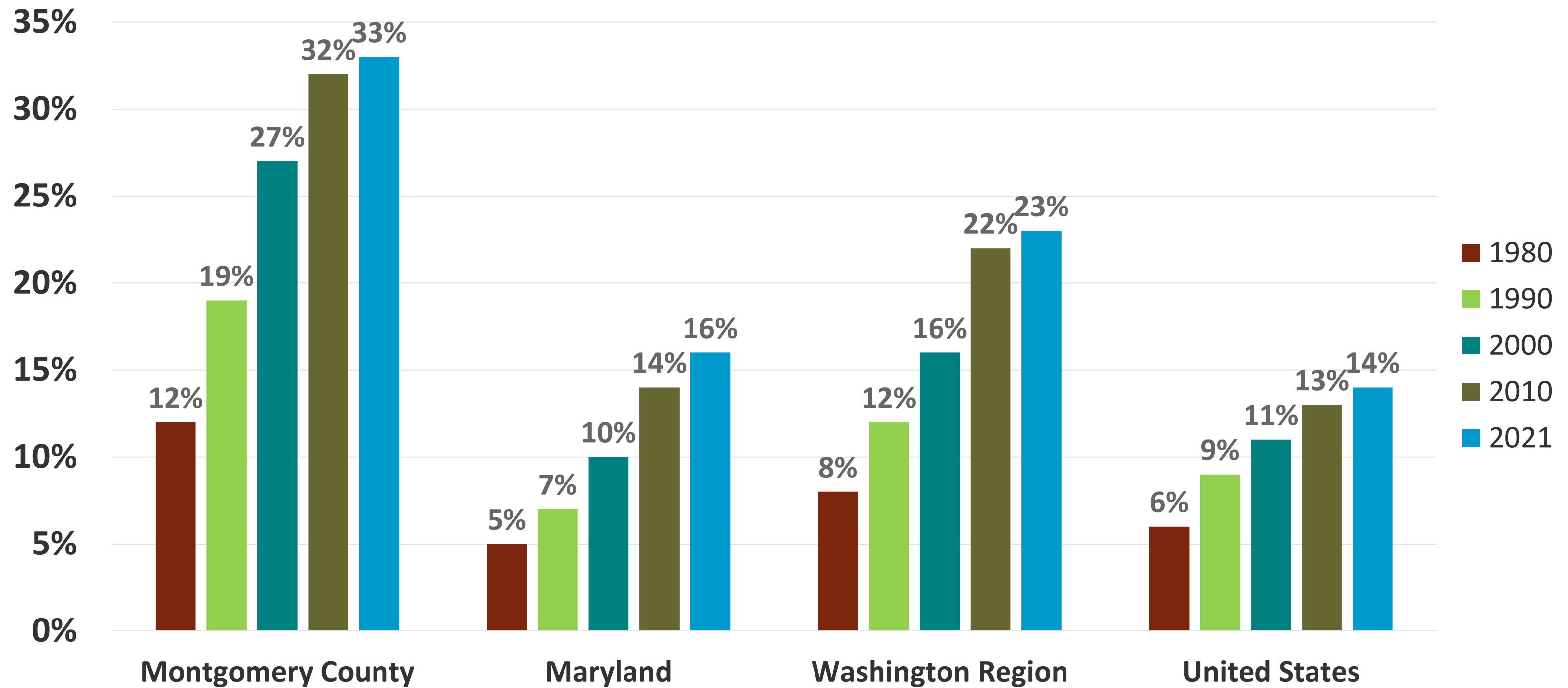

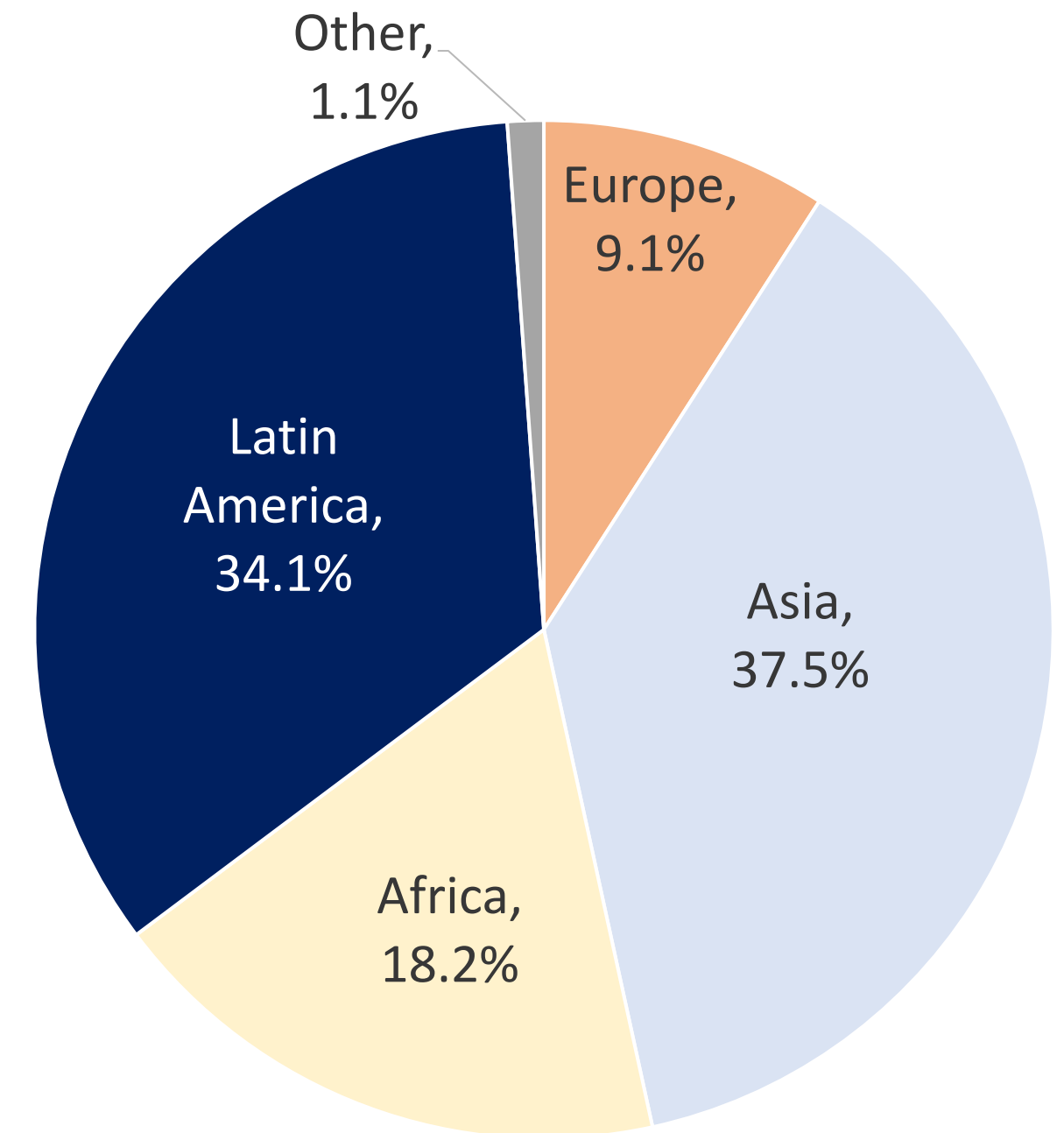

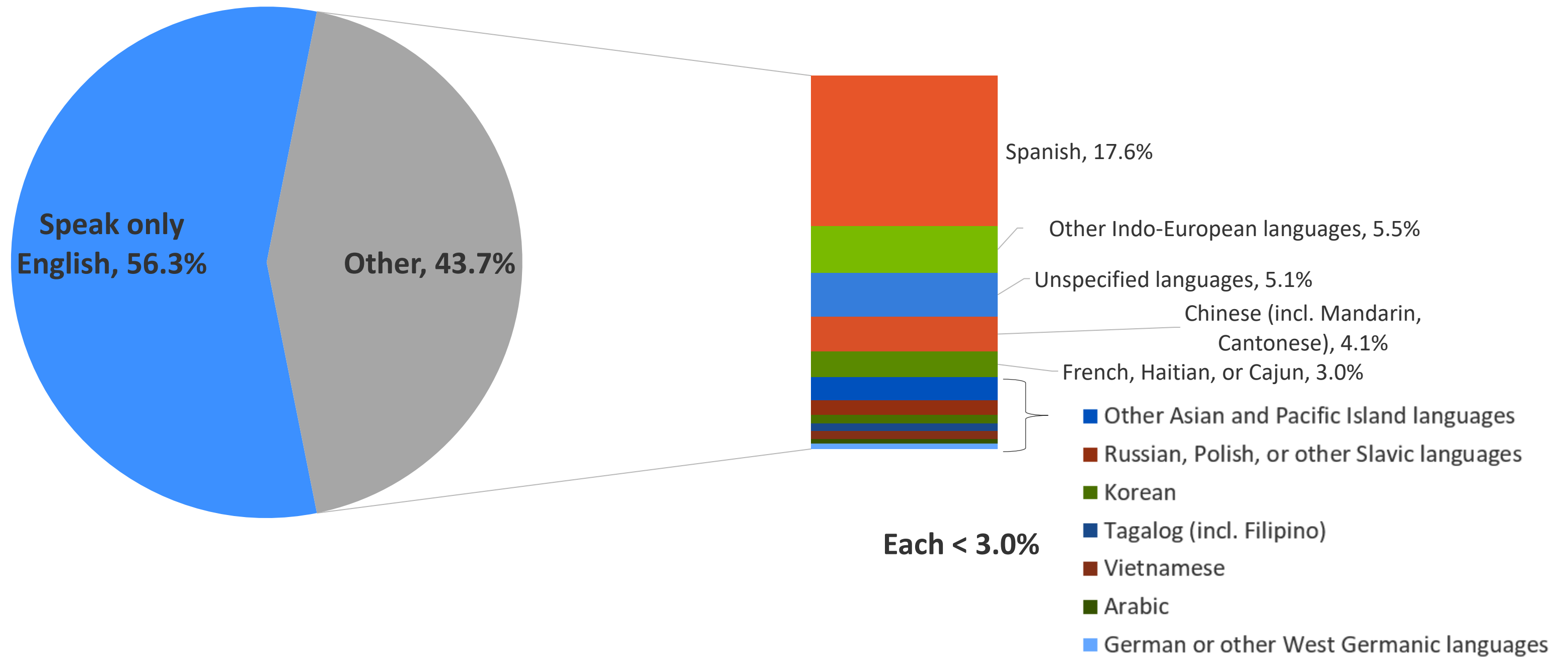

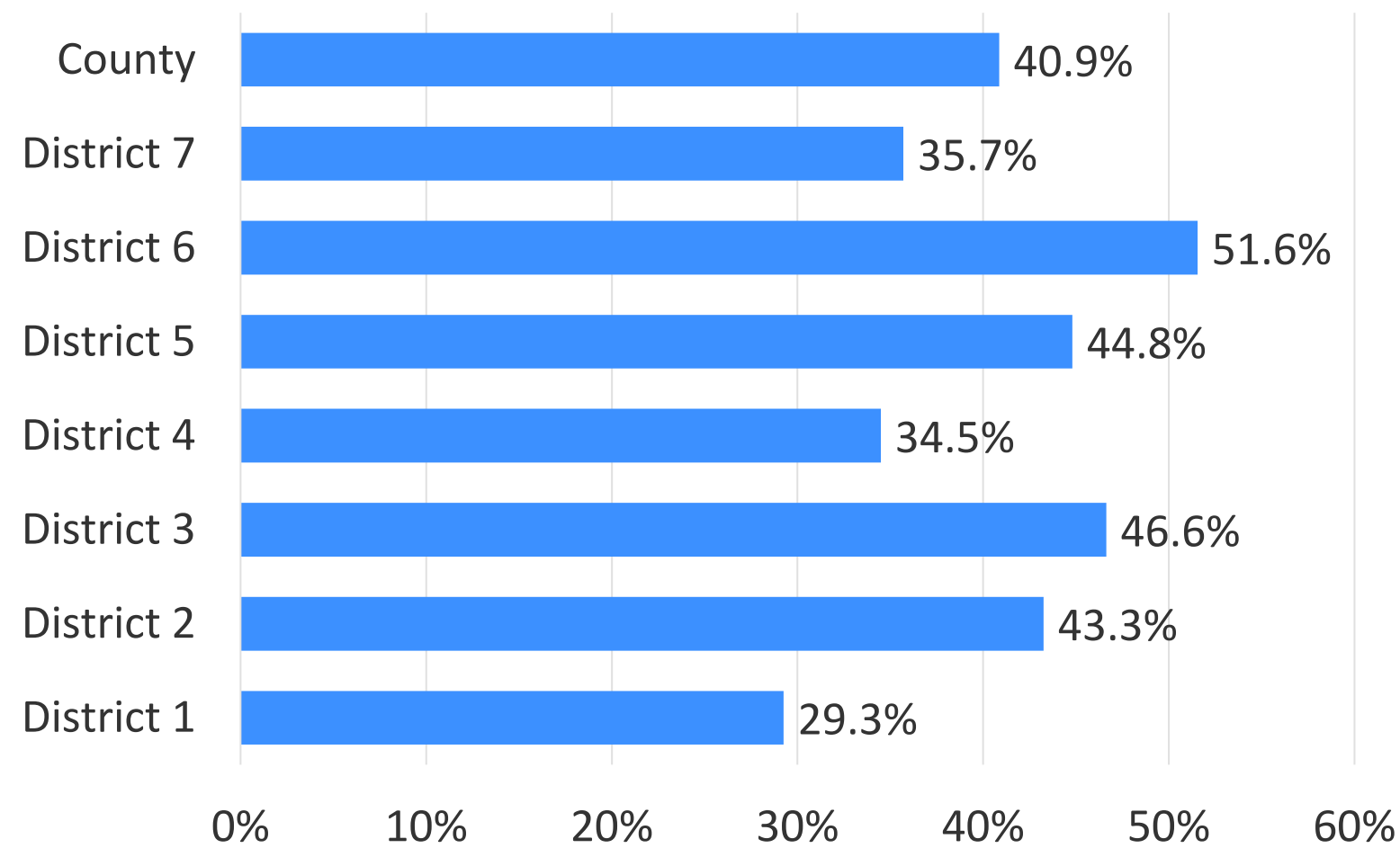

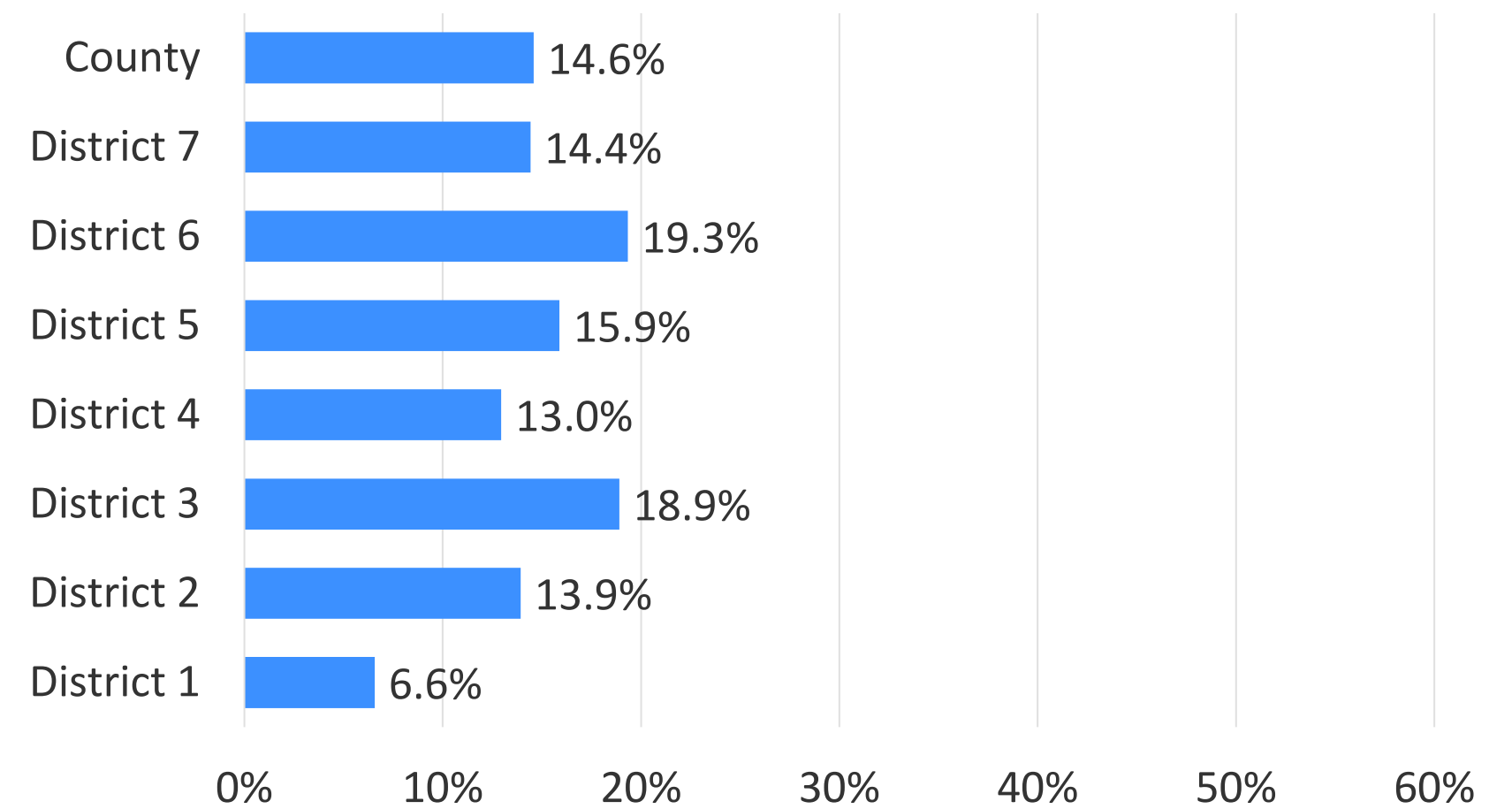

Percentage of residents who speak a language other than English at home



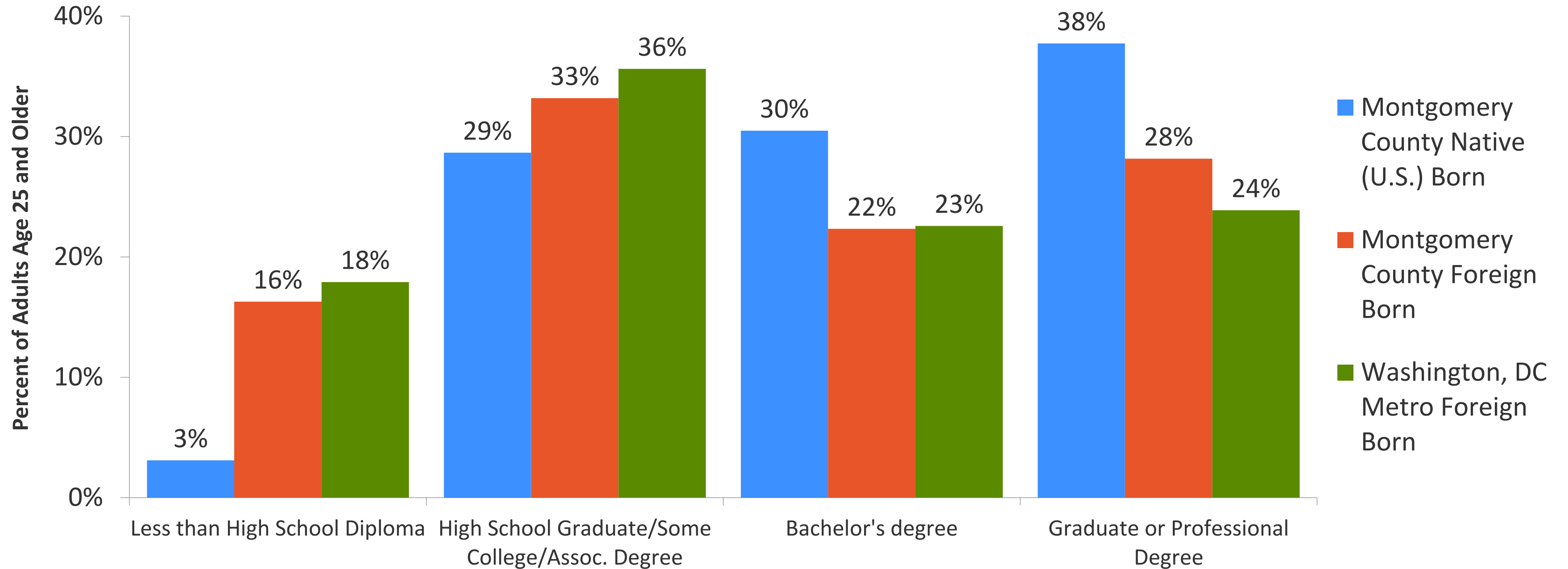
Percentage of residents who report speaking English less than "Very Well"

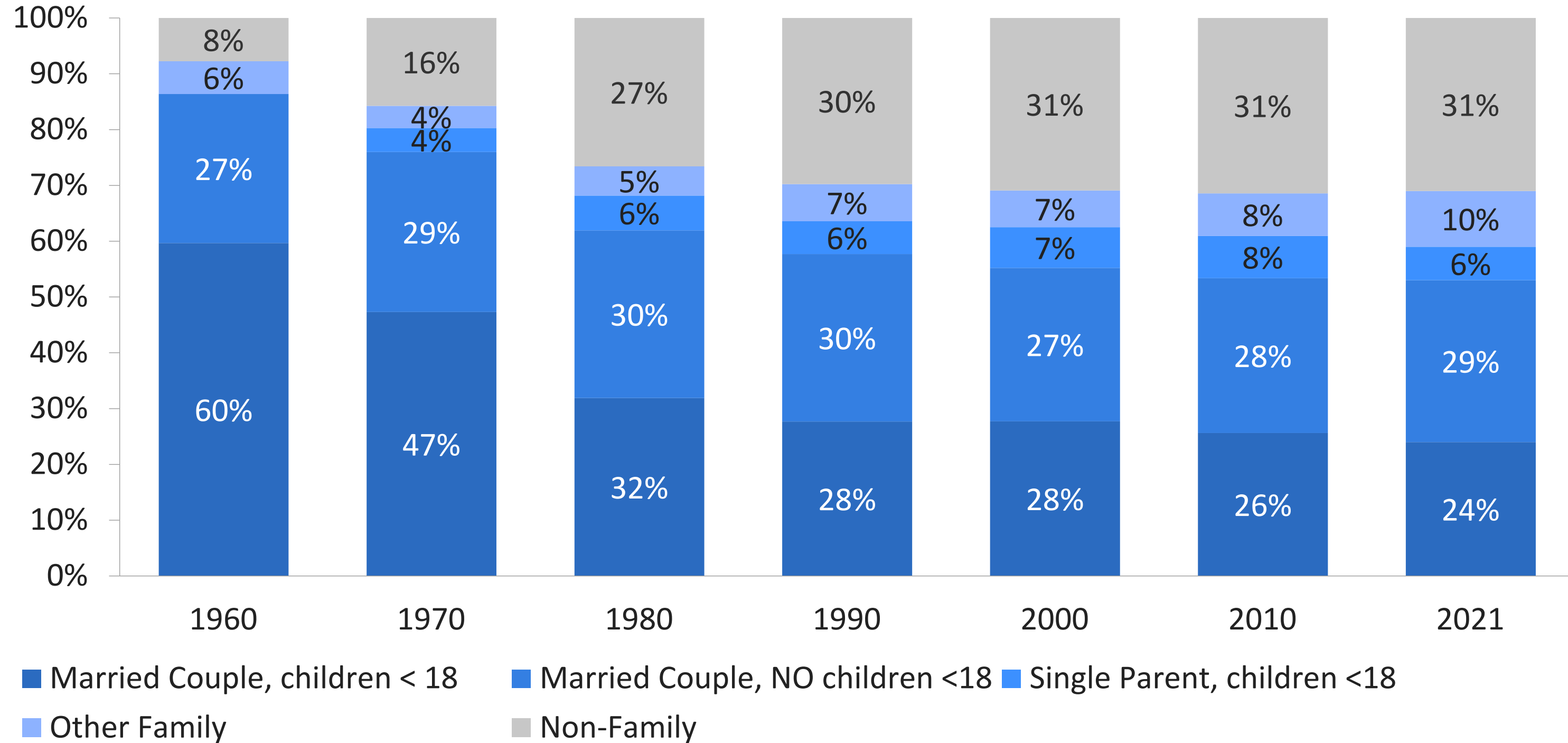
EDUCATIONAL ATTAINMENT OF NATIVE AND FOREIGN BORN (2021)

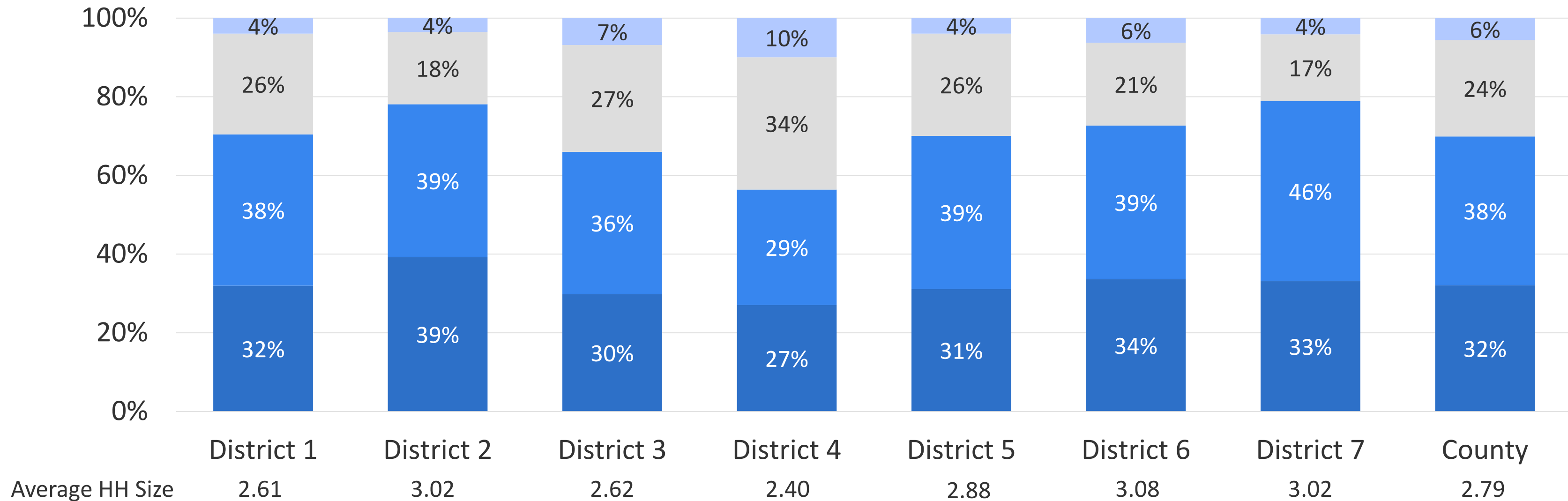
# Household composition (1960-2021)

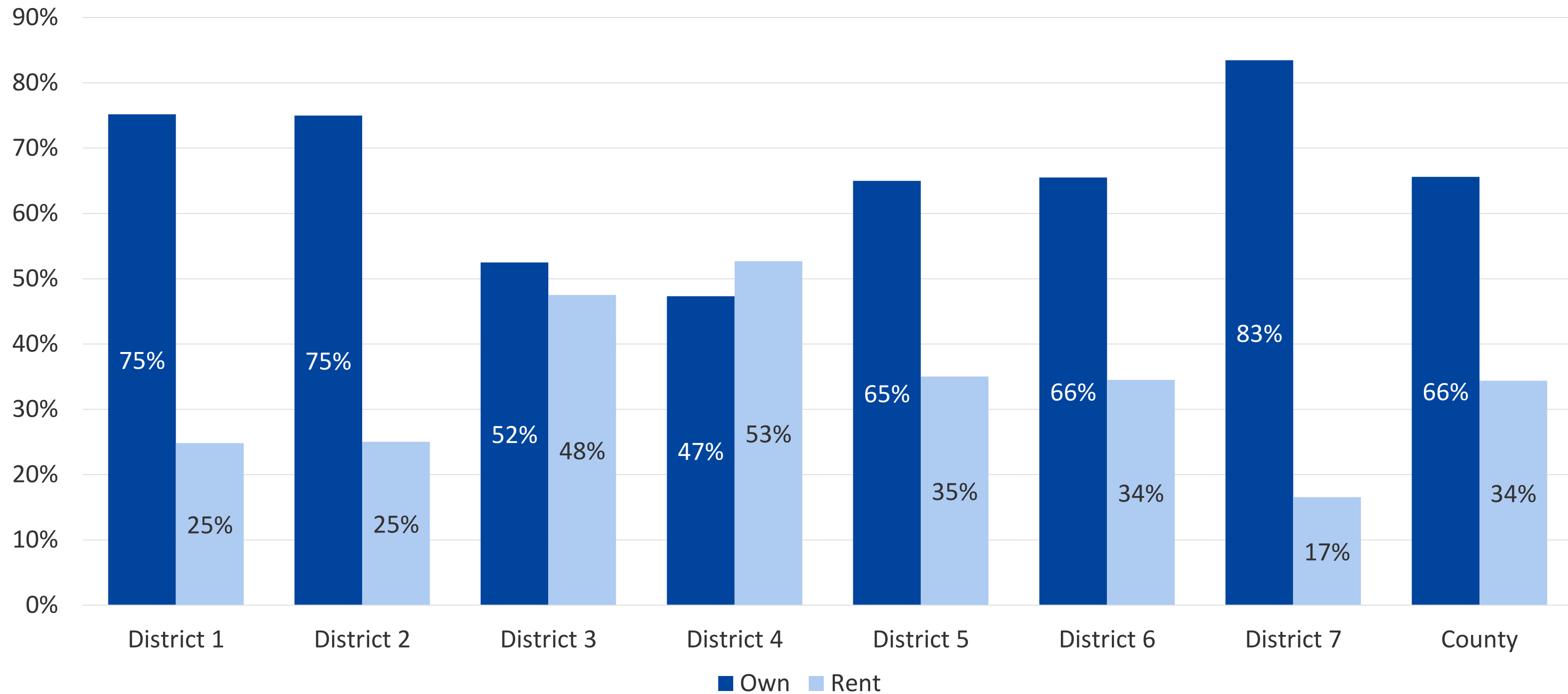

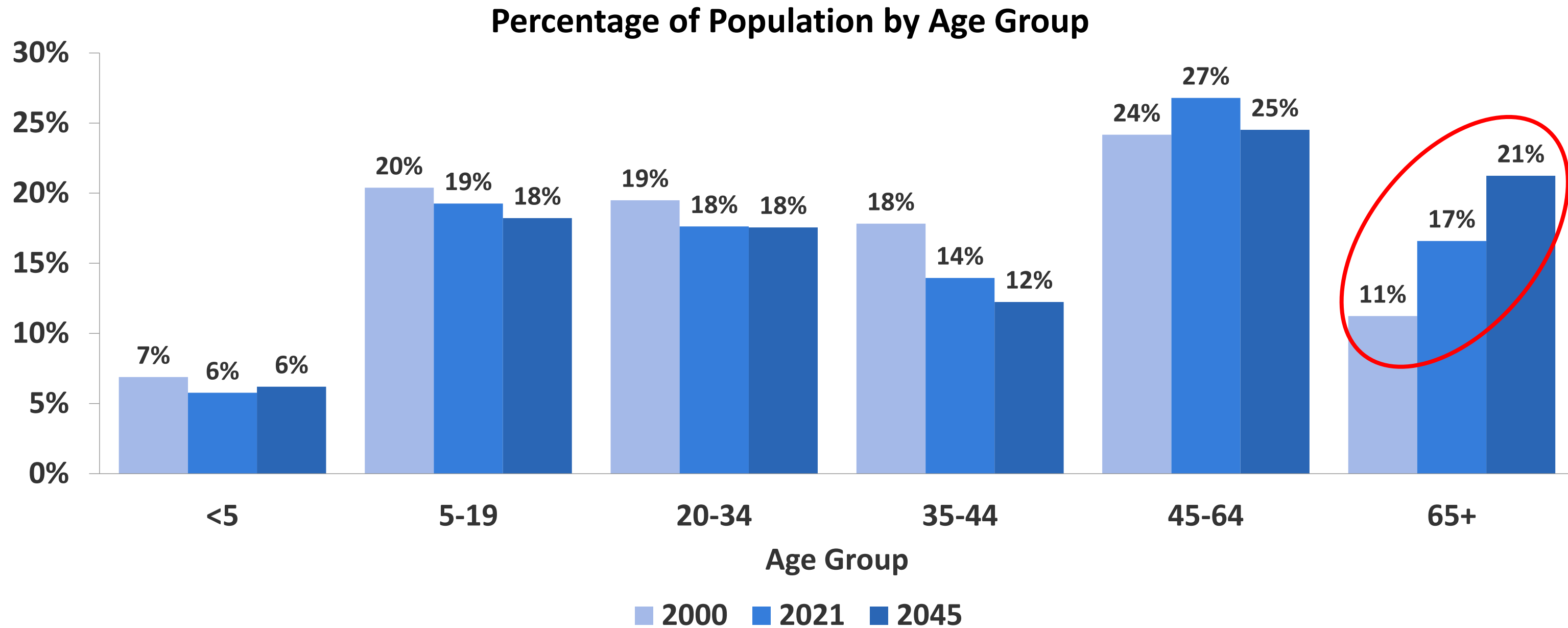


# Housing tenure by district and countywide



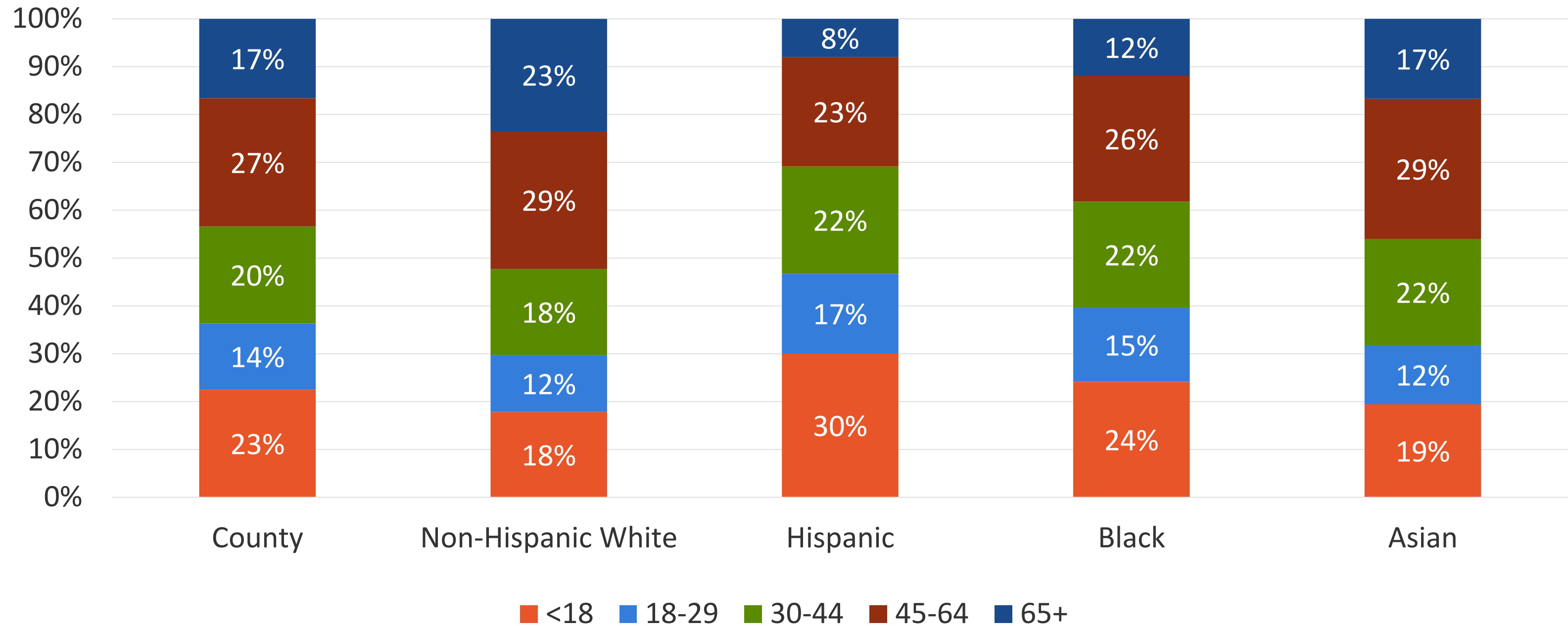

# Population projection by age



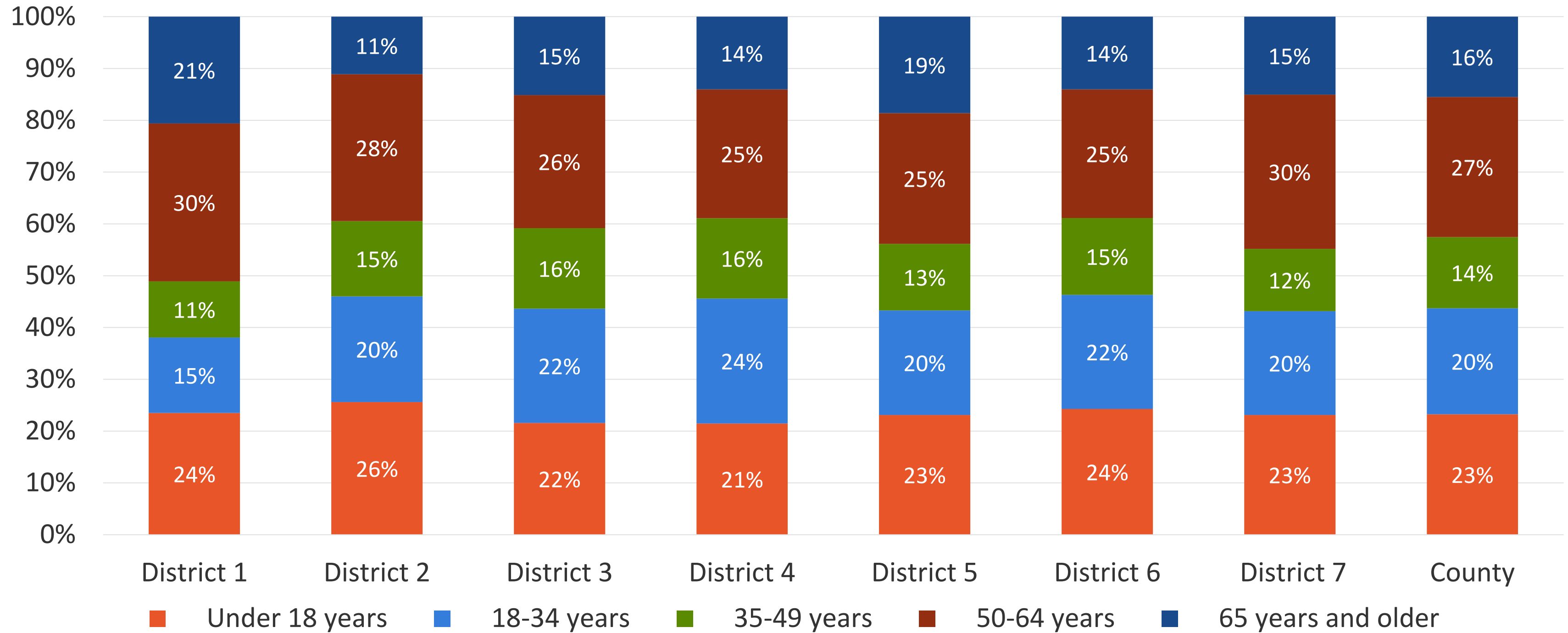

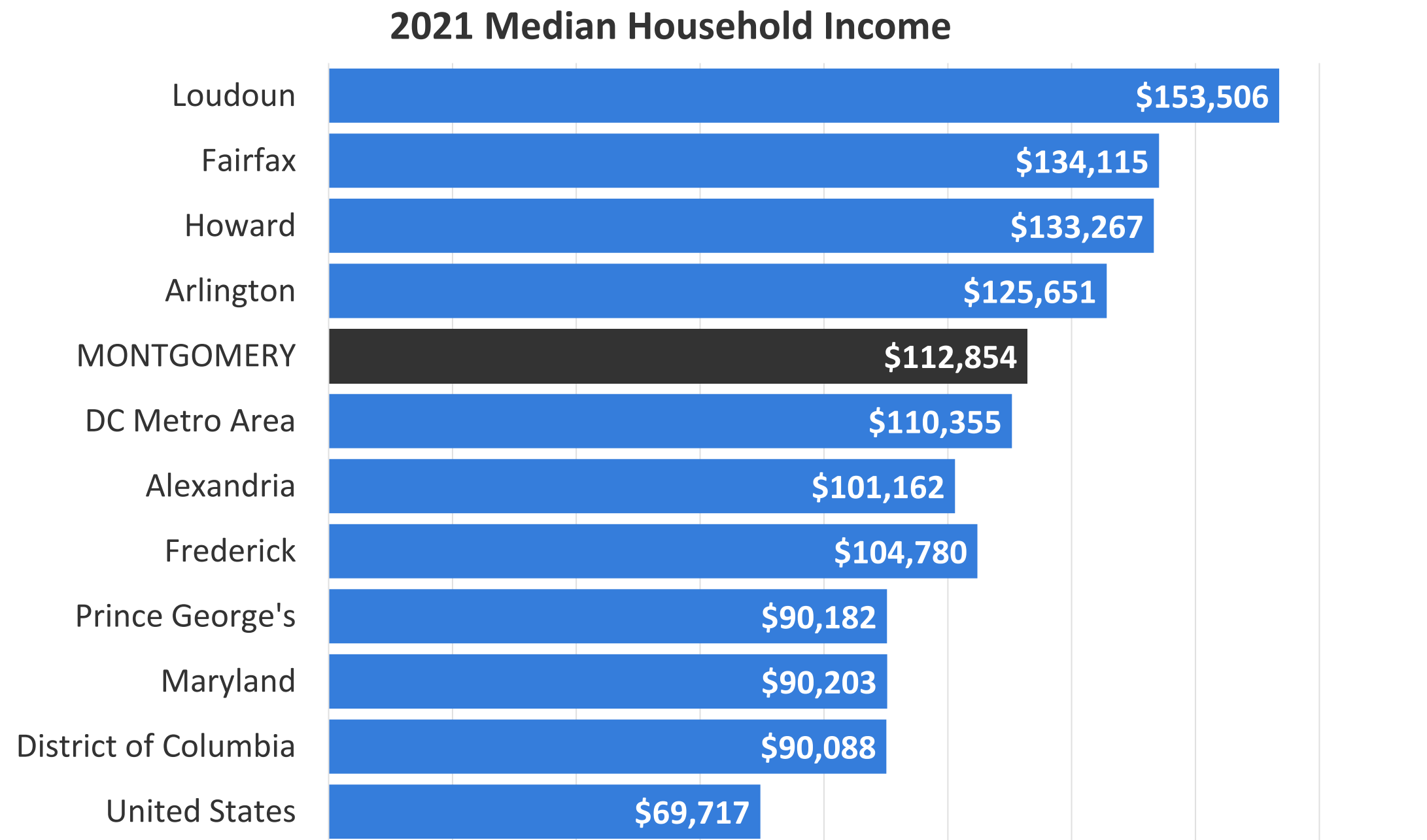

# Median income regional comparison

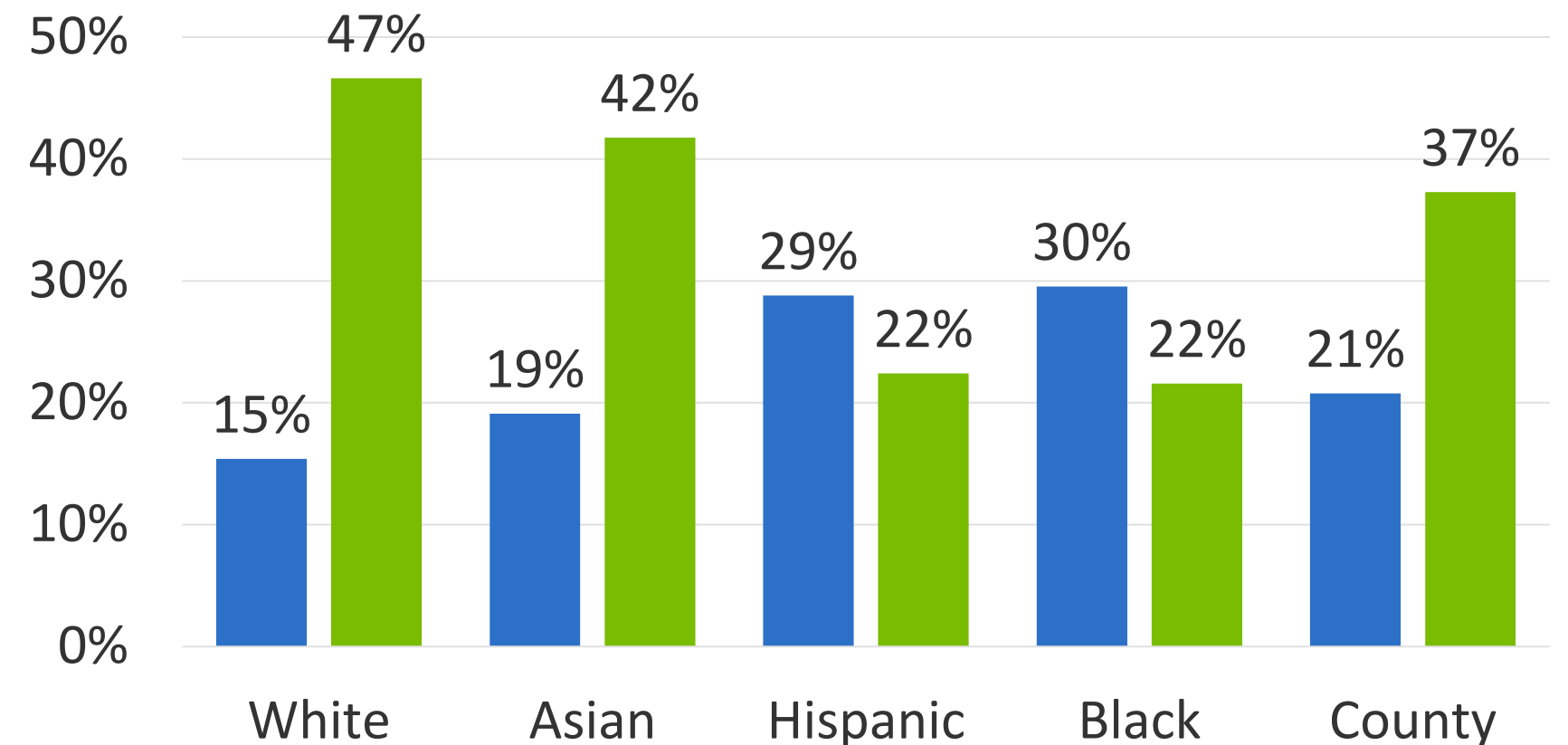

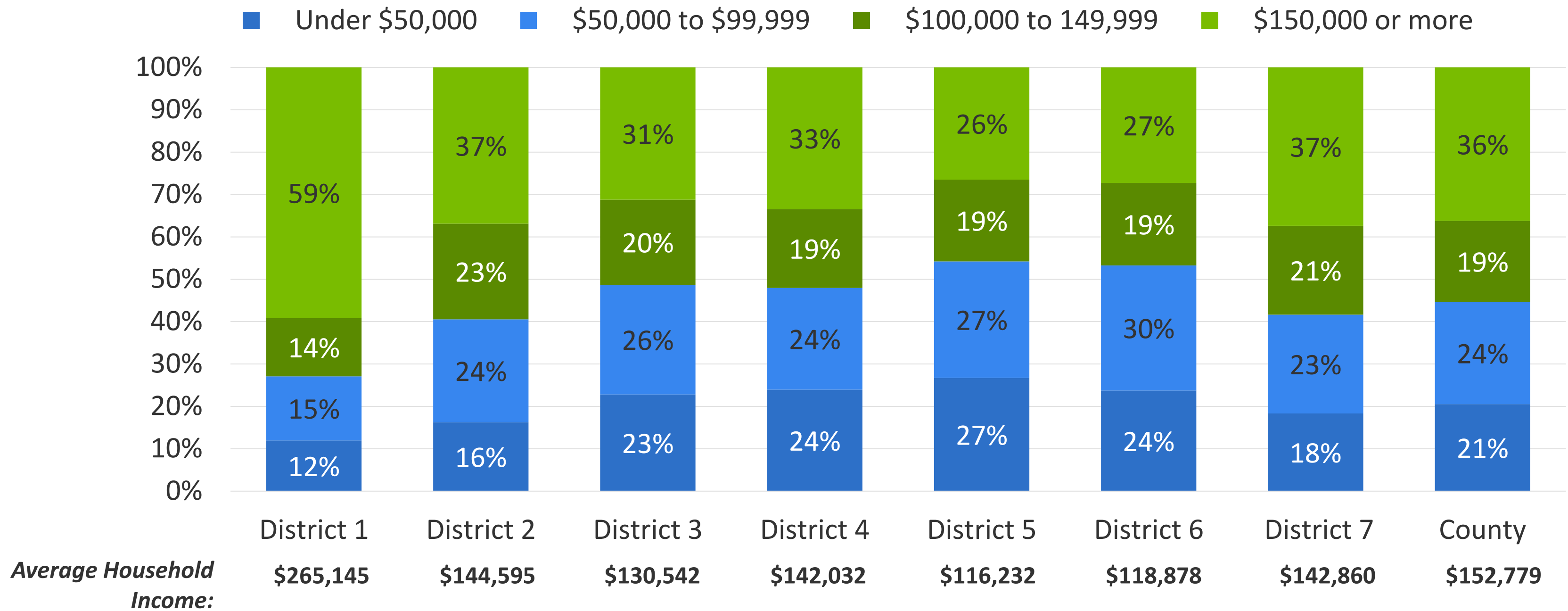

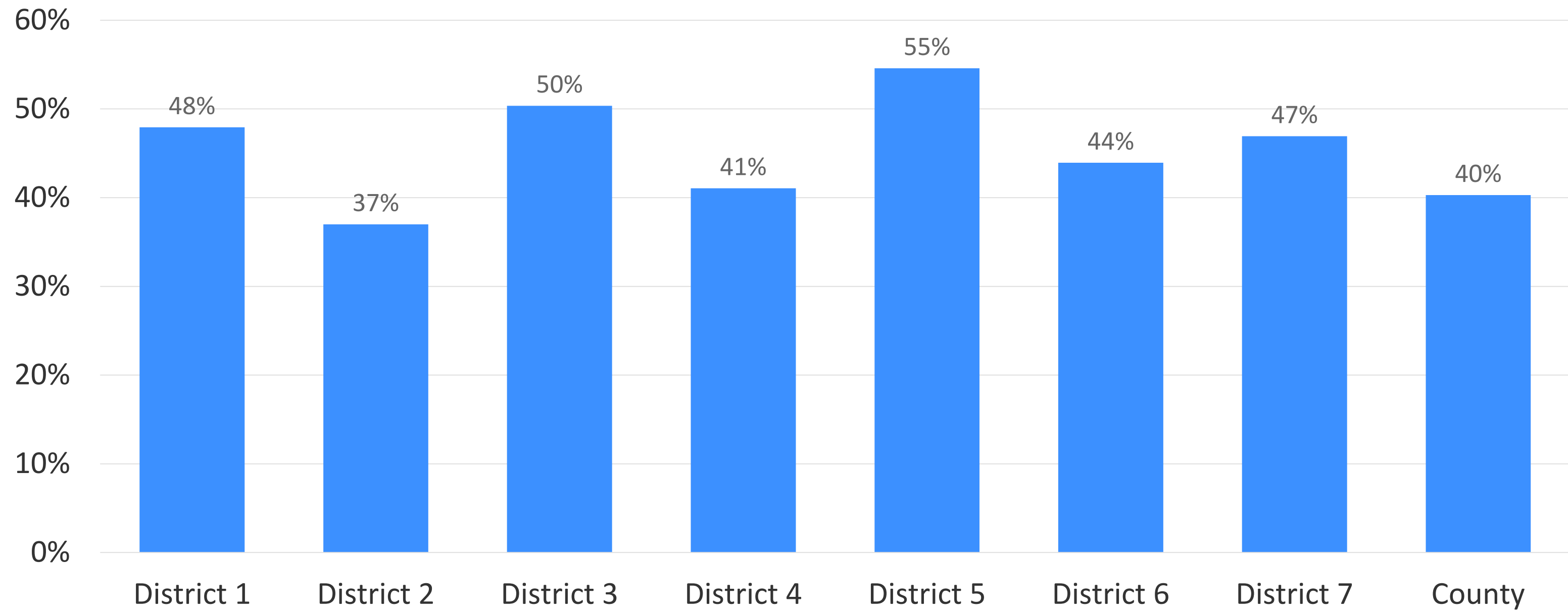
# Income distribution by district and countywide

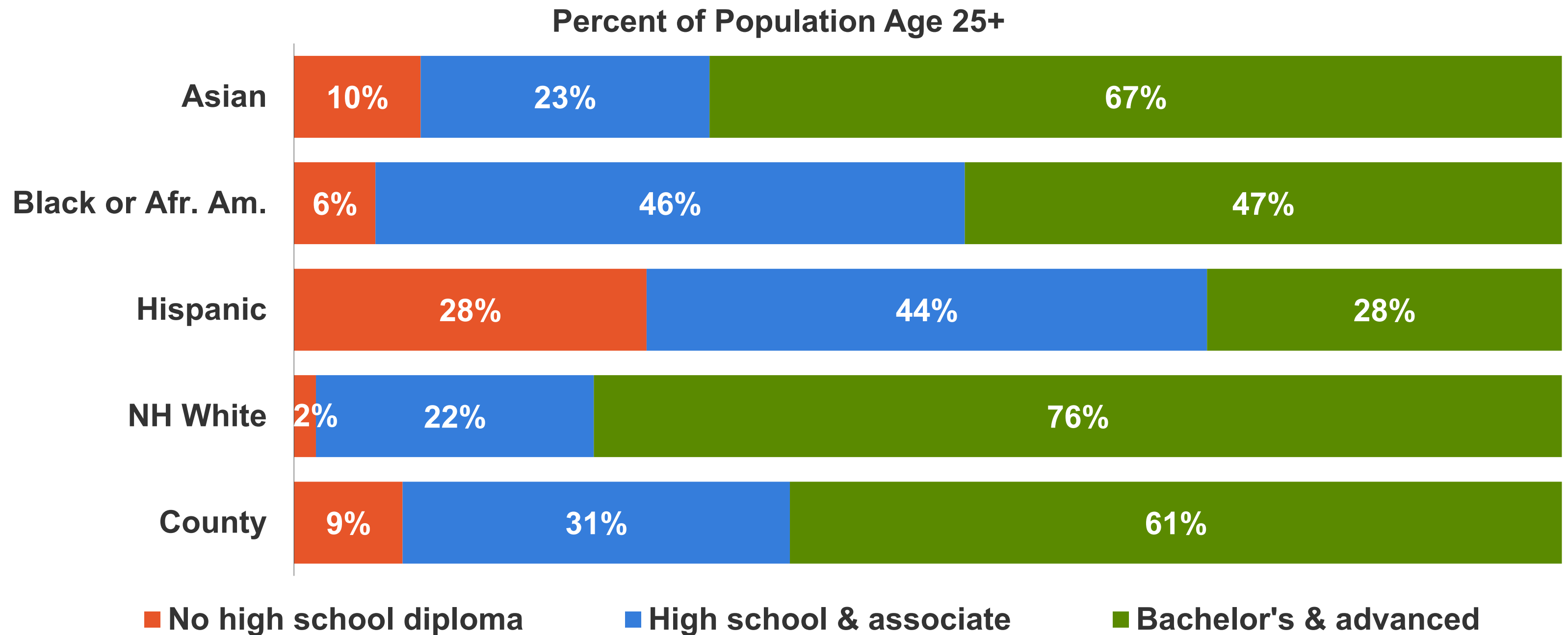


# Percentage of renter households spending >35% of income on housing costs



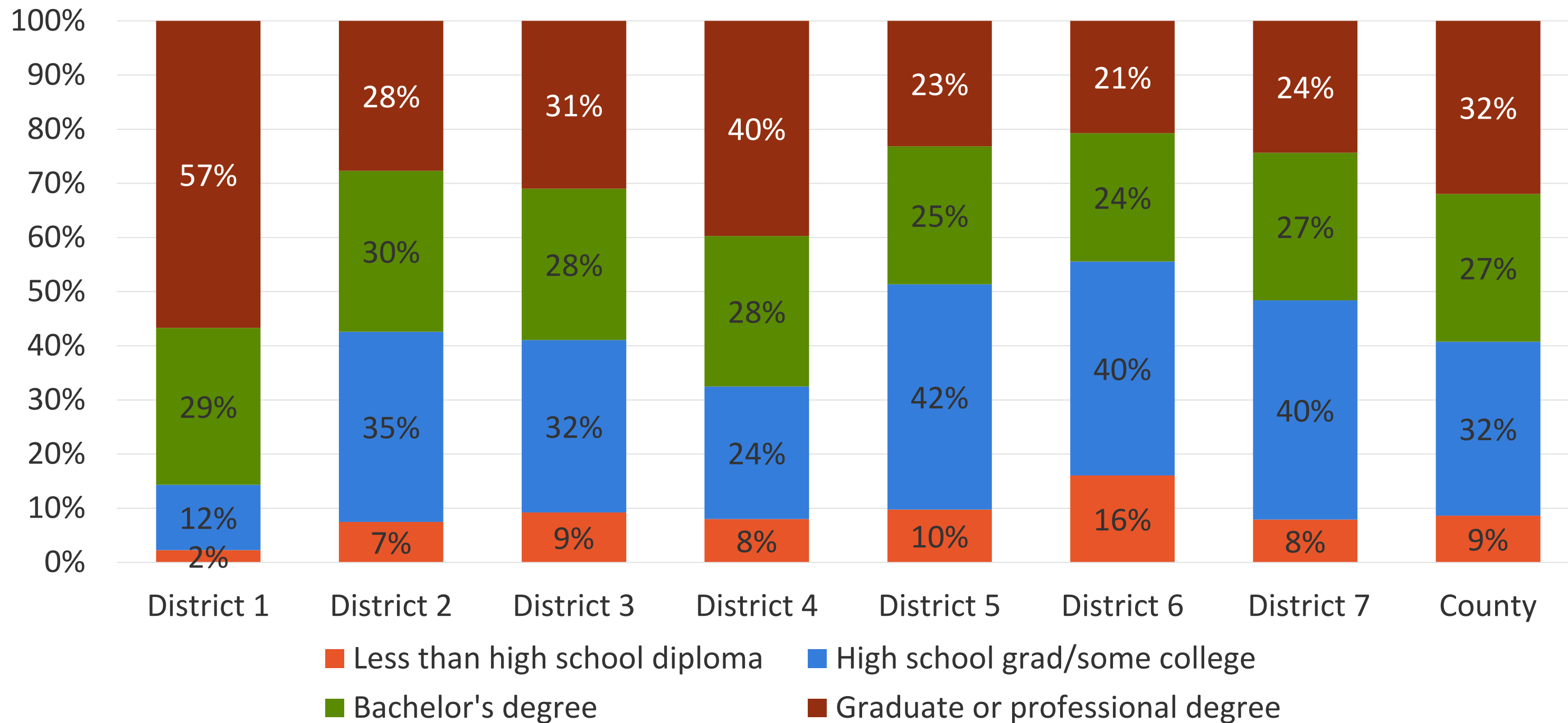

# Educational attainment by race



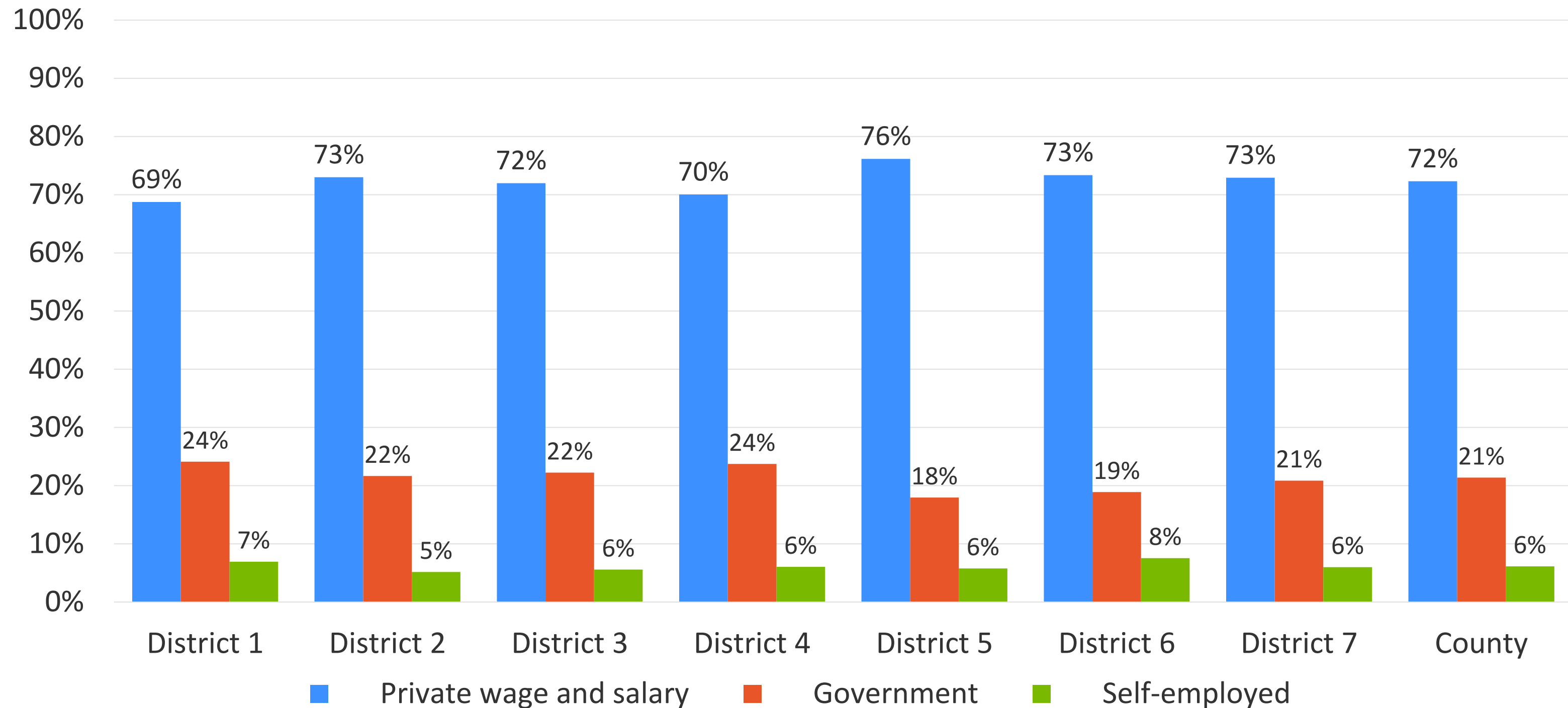

# Educational attainment by district and countywide



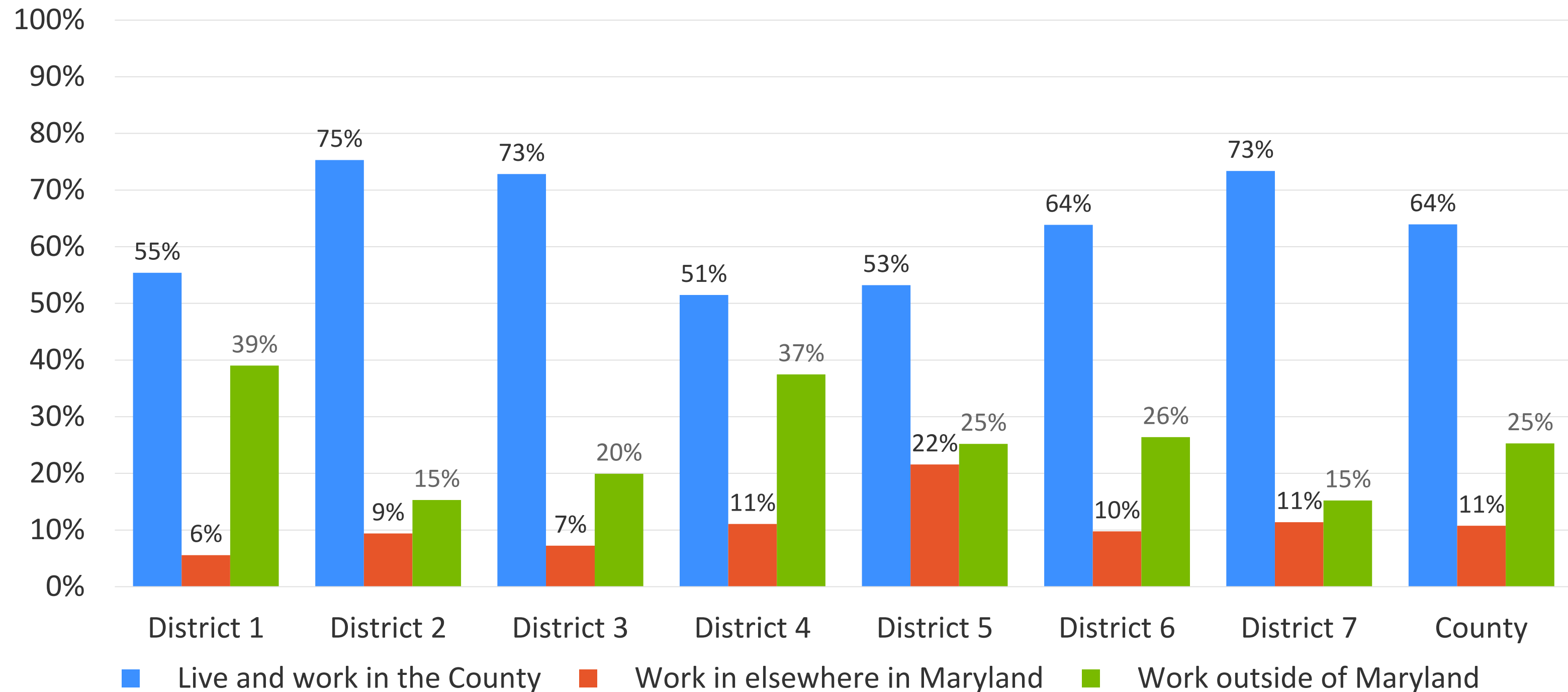

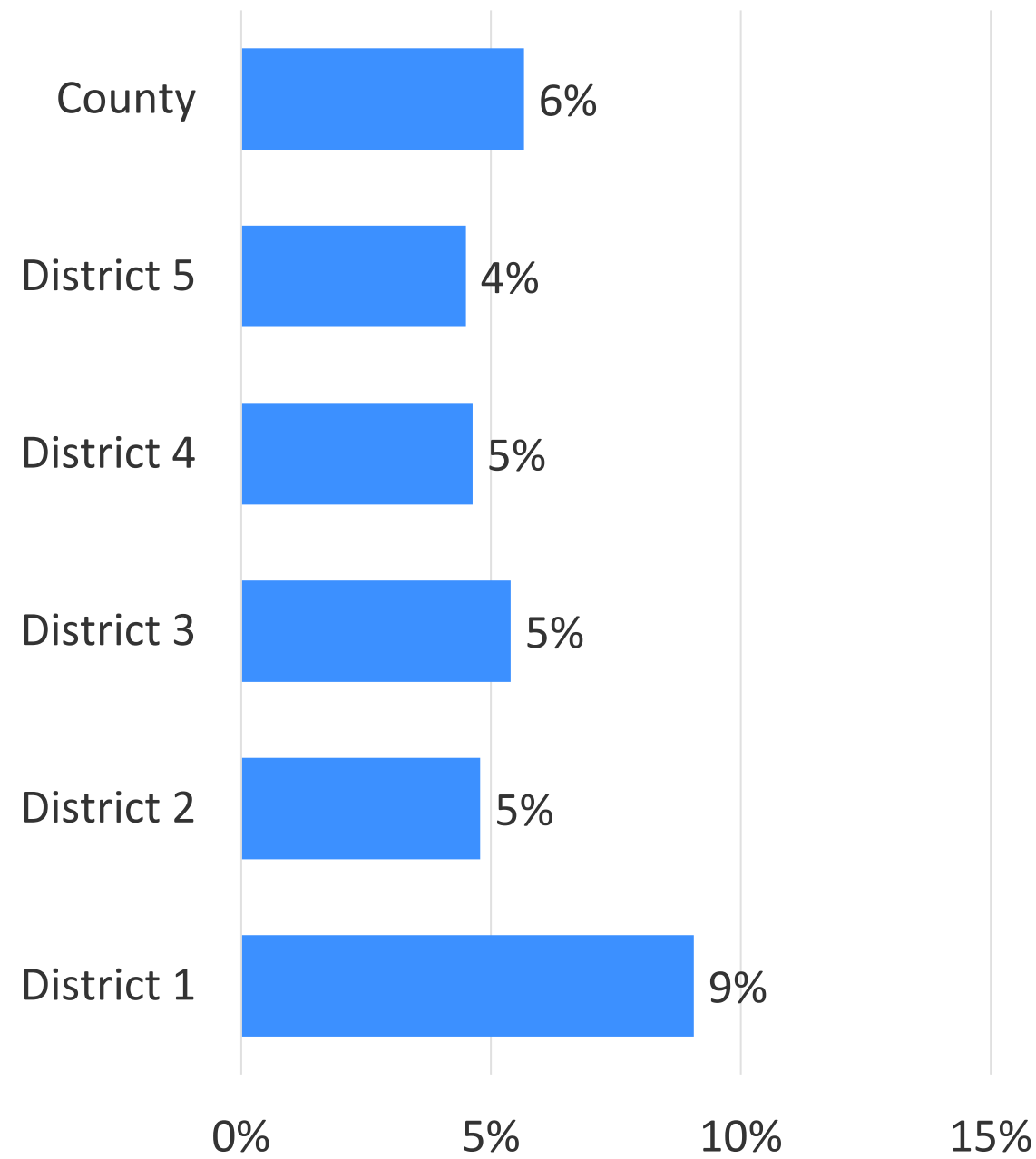
# Place of work by district and countywide



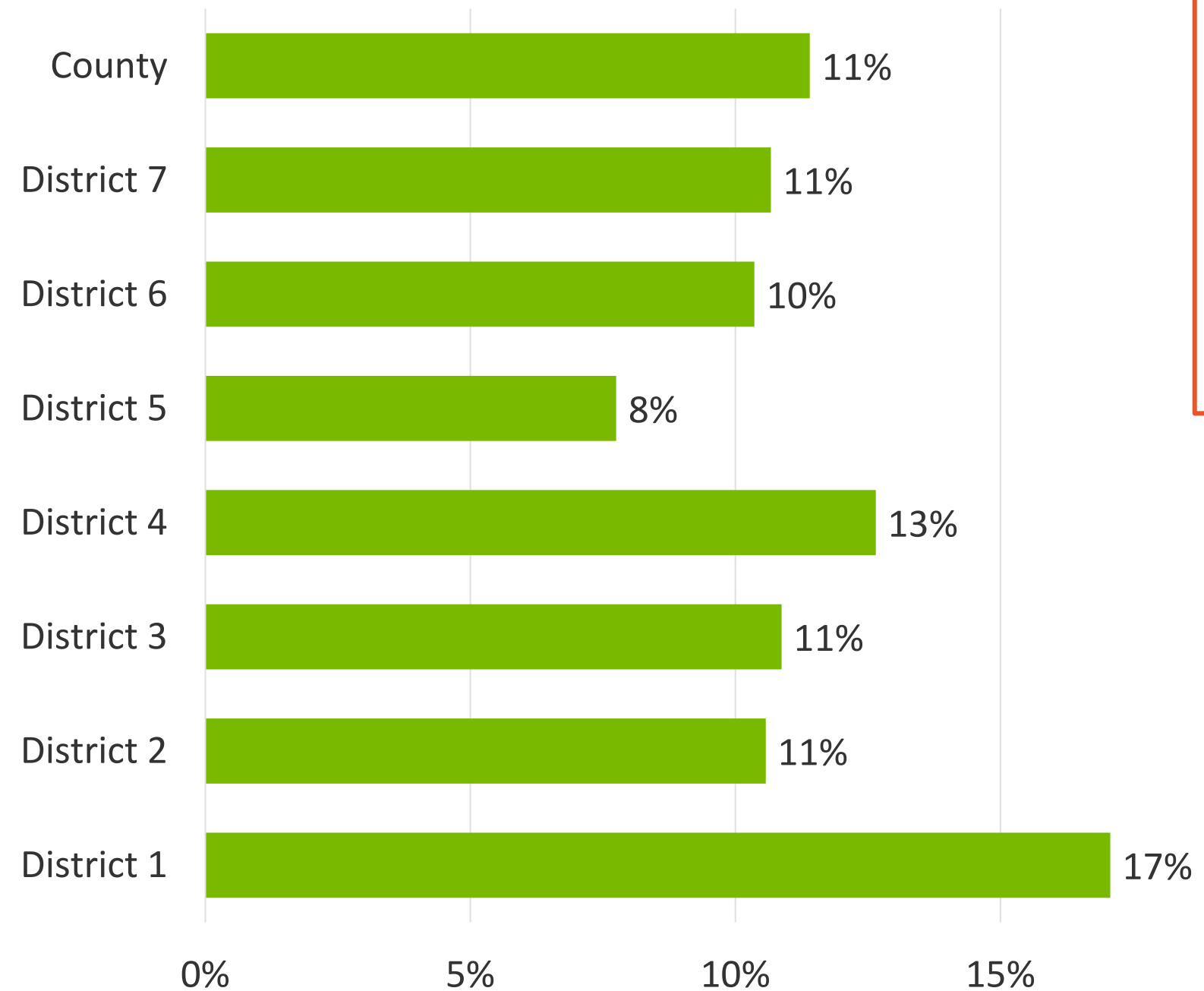

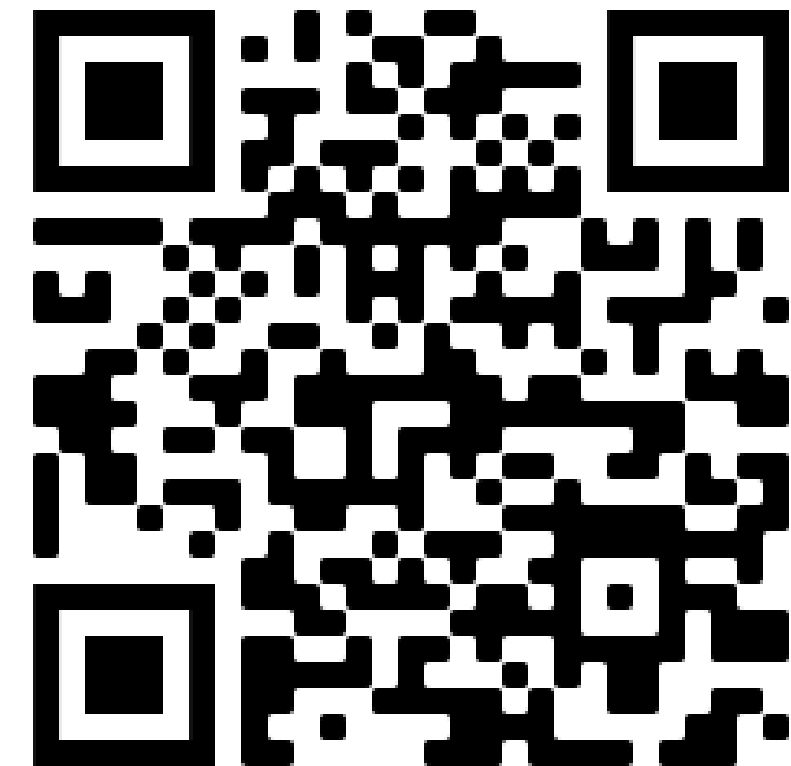
