





- Damage to the brain and nervous system
- Slowed growth and development
- Learning and behavior problems
- Hearing and speech problems

A lead test is the only way to know if a child has been exposed to lead. Children should have a lead test done at age 12 months and 24 months to catch lead exposure early, which can prevent damage to a child's development.
